Hall is Estale Chairman of the County Court of Franklin County Tennessee in the sum of one thousand dollars to which payment will and truly to be made we bind ourselves Executons and administrators jointly and severally by these presents witness our hands & seal this 27th day of May 1830. The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the said Campbell Bradford Woods more than emancipated a certain man named Peter Sately conveyed to them by Isaac Embrey of Franklin County Tennessee Done if the said Isaac Embrey Bradford Woods shall keep the County of Franklin and State of Tennessee and himself as aforesaid dead shall for want of said Peter Salyer ever become chargeable to said County as a pauper then the above obligation to be void else to remain in full force.

To the Worshipfull County Court of Franklin County Tennessee the petition of James Campbell, Joseph H Bradford and James Woods respectfully sheweth that Peter Salyer a negro man above mentioned in the aforesaid bill of sale is his property and by his own industry and good conduct to having & gained a sufficiency of money to liberate or purchase himself that he is a man of upright conduct and character and as such has always declared himself that they wish to see an upstart him & hereby give him his freedom in conformity with the act of assembly and the laws of the Land & all the rights and privileges of other free persons of color in this State. In Testimony whereof we have here set our hands this 27th day 1830.
