 State aforesaid being lawfully qualified that I can't help but a short
 time and being desirous that all my business should be left
 so as to give general satisfaction and give all my children
 as near as equal proportions as is possible and being of sound
 right mind and reasonable services I do hereby in the
 Name of God bequeath and give to Mahala Second of Browning
 my beloved wife the properties herein named to wit I do give her
 the house place where I now live to be hers on
 the following conditions to wit that she is not take in to
 her with her any of the children either here or since nor is
 she to take them out the Dowry But I do give her to run and
 on the place neither is she to wear trappings of off the place
 any farther than is necessary for the use of the place is
 to have the same as long as she lives a widow or her
 Natural life unless she should take the children of
 either party to live with her on the Dowry with them
 in such case she is to be dispossessed of all her
 right and the Dowry of land sold and distributed as follows
 I bequeath the heirs of John A. Duran our act and rights
 Euceline Stafford the heirs of Robert A. Duran and his heirs by his
 present wife and the heirs of Anne of James Brainerd the Dowry
 beginning and lying as follows to wit commencing at the field
 Race three corners up the hill by where a run off
 forked chestnut has fallen down then by a well cherry
 standing near the fence and road Southward then
 thence South, direction to the Anderson branch so as to
 show out James Brainerd's House thence up the Anderson
 branch to Charles Lane thence so as to include the west
 end of my land it being all I own west of the said
 Lane I also give and bequeath to my wife a certain Red
 Cow and calf and all my hogs and five head of sheep and a
 certain two year old Billy dark body black face
 with three white feet and two Bids of turkeys and Kitchen

furniture & all she is to have my Bond ^{and} following deep Table which
 General ^{and} West all of which my wife is to have her natural or
 during her widowhood upon the same conditions of her dowry
 of land also I will ^{and} bequeath to America a Jew Brace my
 my daughter the following property to wit a certain tract
 of parcel of land ^{and} other property ^{and} other things amounting
 to eight hundred ^{and} fifty dollars being part of my house
 tract ^{and} lying & described as follows to wit Beginning on the
 South East boundary of the Downy running a Southern
 direction to the foot of the hill so as to include the Spring
 thence running toward the branch to a large Elm standing
 near the branch thence a East direction to a corner at the
 cross fence at the grave yard thence with the cross
 fence straight down the hill in fifty yords of the house
 standing alone the well thence of North direction to the
 race so as to miss the stable ^{and} Oaks thence with the
 race to the North Eastern Corner of Downy with the Downy
 Southern direction to the beginning all of which I bequeath
 to my daughter America of Jew Brace ^{and} her bodily heirs
 to have & her ^{and} her heirs forever I also will ^{and} bequeath
 to William Alexander ^{and} James Robert Brown the lawful
 heirs of James Robert Brown Doves the following tract
 of land it also being a part of my house tract to wit
 Beginning at a large Elm it being the same in which my
 daughter America of Jew comes on running down the hill
 to H. Curwens house thence East north the same to the Taylor
 St since thence North with the same to an Elm tree
 said since thence a west direction with the fence to the
 corner of America Jones above the well thence with this
 a Southern direction to the grave yard thence Southern
 direction to the beginning it being all that the said William
 Alexander ^{and} James Roberts is due to have & I want
 their Mother to live on the same ^{and} have the use of it
 to raise the the children out of my estate I wish Robert
 Overseer to be their guardian to see that their property
 is rightly managed also I bequeath to my daughter
 Martha of Jew as much Curwens a certain tract of land ^{and}
 other property amounting to eight hundred ^{and} fifty
 dollars which is already due to her also I have
 bequeathed to Robert A. Overly who married my
 daughter Nancy £100 hundred ^{and} fifty dollars which
 he has received ^{and} said Overly is to have enough out
 of the Estate to make his share equal to the others which
 makes him due 200 hundred dollars to make him
 up equal to the others thus which he must have out
 of the church money collected I give to my daughter
 Rebecca Annine Stafford 200 hundred dollars which
 she has received in land ^{and} money I also will that

my mill tract of land supposed to contain twenty five or
thirty acres which he sold on one two ^{and} three years
ago. And I appoint Robert A. Overby my Executor to sell
said lands Collect for the same. Also I will that my
other tract containing about one hundred acres lying on
the South side of Ashmans Branch adjoining James Shosters
I will it being the tract Eselle I have and ^{also} also an-
other tract lying adjoining Bryan Brandon containing
about twelve acres. I also want Robert A. Overby to sell
all on the same terms. Collect ^{and} if pay over according to
law. Also I will ^{that} the matter that James Wade Smith my
grand son have fifty dollars & three as Francis W. Lunden
Smith my ^{grand} grand child have one hundred each. I also
want all my debts paid & my calls paid that is due
me ^{and} equally divided between ^{and} the Executive Robert A.
Overby who married my daughter Nancy. I further want
that my daughter & also three that Robert Overby sell
my British slave property at public sale Collect ^{and} pay over
as directed before. This is my last will ^{and} testament ^{and}
I do hereby set my hand ^{and} affix my seal this day ^{and}
date above written

that all of my just debts ^{and} funeral expenses be paid
2nd I give ^{and} bequeath unto my son H. P. Aplin
eighty acres of my land it being the South West portion
of my land lying on the South West corner of my
land running East thence North West ^{and} South for
complement to thence into his possession at this time ^{and}
to have ^{and} to hold the same during his natural life time
^{and} at his death then to go to his children 2nd I will ^{and}
bequeath unto my second wife Elizabeth Aplin the
residue and of my land which is about one hundred acres
which she is to have for her own use ^{and} benefit during
her natural life time ^{and} after her death I will ^{and} direct
that the lands I will to my wife be sold by my
Executor and one ^{and} two years after the proceeds of the
same to be equally divided between my five daughters
to wit Rebecca & Smith son of H. Shosters Mary E. Strall
Judith Jennings & Nancy C. Figg 3rd I will ^{and} bequeath
unto my grand son James D. Aplin one house & stable
