I John M. Bennett of the County of Harrison & State of Indiana doth make & publish this my last Will & Testament hereby revoking & making void all former Will & Testament hereby theretofore made. First, I desire that all the debts & unpaid outgoings money that I may be possessed of or may hereafter come into the hands of my Executors from any portion of my Estate Real & Personal, Secondly I will & bequeath to my Wife Sarah Bennett all the property that she brought with her from her Father & also all the property she may inherit from the estate of her Father & her and her children & children's children & Benjamin F. Bennett & in addition one house & lot in Richland Depot during her life time or widowhood then such & divided with balance of the same. I also will & bequeath to Emma Morris one negro girl named Mary in addition to what she has had already had; I also will & bequeath to Hutchinson K. Bennett's heirs five dollars that is to say John K. Bennett, Lacyburg, & I Bennett & Eliza Abith Bennett in addition to what they have already received. I also will & bequeath to Elias A. Bennett his one fourth part of my effects after the debts & donations herein named his & his wife's in addition to that he has had that is to say John M. Bennett & Henry K. Bennett & Eliza Abith Bennett & Eliza Bennett & I Bennett & Eliza Abith Bennett & I also will & bequeath to Mary A. Bennett one sixth part of my effects after the above named payments is made & I will my Rail Road Stock in addition to what she has had. I also will & bequeath to John J. Bennett fifty dollars in money and one sixth part in addition to what he has received. I also will & bequeath to Sarah A. Branton one sixth part of my effects in addition to what she has had. I also will & bequeath unto Francis M. Bennett one sixth part of my effects after the herein named payments is made. I also will & bequeath unto Benjamin F. Bennett \$300. Three hundred dollars for schooling purposes and one sixth part of my effects of mine after all the payments & donations herein mentioned. I also wish Francis M. Bennett to have the guardianship of Mary A. Bennett until she may apply to the Court of said State to be appointed some one else. And if any of the heirs die without heirs of their own body I will & bequeath that case the property to revert back to the heirs named in this my last Will & Testament. I also wish all my property sold and the negroes & their divided between the 6 said heirs that is to say Elias A. Bennett, Mary A. Bennett, John J. Bennett, Sarah A. Branton, Francis M. Bennett & Benjamin F. Bennett. I John M. Bennett doth appoint Francis M. Bennett & Joseph M. Bennett my Executors to carry

out this my last Will and Testament Nov 1st 1859 this part
 of my number Eighteen hundred and fifty nine
 Thus the last Will and Testament of John McBurnett
 John McBurnett is as presented out of
 Court for Probate at the November Term 1875. And the
 handwriting of the said John McBurnett the testator was
 duly proved by the Oaths of Alb. Prator J. F. Burnett and the
 same was ordered to be recorded. Witness my hand at

In the name of God Amen. I Joseph H. Trigg of the County
 of Franklin and State of Tennessee being of sound mind and
 memory and considering the uncertainty of this frail and
 transitory life do make therefore and publish and declare
 this to be my last Will and Testament that is to say first
 after all of my Lawful debts are paid and discharged the
 residue of my estate real and personal I give and bequeath and
 dispose of as follows to wit To my much beloved wife
 Eliza Trigg and my son Thomas Trigg I give the tract of
 land lying on the Louisville Road including the Bohm
 tract for two years at the end of two years they shall
 receive it by distribution between all my heirs for the
 use and benefit of said land then the said Eliza and Thomas
 Trigg shall maintain educate and support my children to wit
 Eliza and for the James Nancy Dubas and Fanny Trigg now
 in possession of the above named children shall on my death
 the two years then they shall have their proportion of
 the residue of my estate or remaining two years
 that may come unto the hands of my Executors I also
 give to my wife Eliza and son Thomas Trigg all the stock of every
 description and all the corn fodder and oats Bacon &c. &c.
 all the household and kitchen furniture all the stock on
 hand at the end of the two years shall be returned
 for a distribution between all my heirs. In addition
 to the above I give to my wife Eliza Trigg one thousand
 dollars out of my money to be paid in cash at my
 death for the purpose of building a dwelling house on said
 Farm. At the end of the two years my wife Eliza Trigg
 shall have choice of her interest in any of my lands
 belonging to said Estate the house next to the graveyard to her
 if she shall make choice of the house tract or so much
 thereof as she shall see her interest in said estate.
 All lands lying on the North side of Lane Hall and
 Pains Creek I give in the hands of my much beloved
 son John Trigg for two years including the steel and
