 of my plantation for her support during her life the rest of my
 property I allow to be sold the proceeds of which I also allow for
 the support of my wife during her life at her death it is my
 Will that all the property shall be sold and disposed of as
 follows: The share of my children takes one of her or she may
 see cause to live with I allow thirty dollars. I allow each
 of my sons John three children John Isaac & David five
 dollars each the balance to be equally divided amongst all
 my children I also nominate and appoint John Siler and
 Maudlin Reese sole Executors of this my last Will and
 Testament hereby revoking all former Wills and Testaments by me
 made & witnesses whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal
 this 2nd July 1821. Signed Sealed published and declared by the
 above named John Conner to be his last Will and Testament in
 presence of us who at his request again his presence here be-
 lieve to be entered our names for witnesses to the same
