 do make my full and last will & testament first I
 do it that all my just debts be paid out of monies that I
 may be possessed or may hereafter come into the hands of my
 Executor (who will be hereafter named) I give the collection of
 debts due me or from the sale of property or otherwise
 Item 2^d I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Susan Burt
 the following property to wit Buffalo, Borchony, Liberty & her
 child to my daughter with her increase (which I may increase)
 I also give her one negro boy named Louell that I have
 called Howard and is son of my all to the use of my wife
 Thier & assigns forever Item 3^d I bequeath to my wife Susan
 one negro boy named Anthony during her natural life widow-
 hood (son of Borchony) I bequeath to her said son of Anthony & Thier
 1st I give to my wife Susan her Bed & furniture & three linen
 including thirty six pairs of sheets choice Beds & of French as I
 may be in possession of. I also give to my wife Susan all the
 Eastern China & Glass ware that I may be in possession of together
 with four sets Thier & glass all the spoons except the silver
 ones & then I bequeath to her during her natural life or widow-
 hood I also give her one of the Bedsteads now in the house and
 one other I bequeath her during life I also give her the newest
 set of the two I now hold & Eighteen sitting chairs such
 as I now have in possession for Table soaking Glass four
 Table Tables & cover I also give her as many Tables as she
 may need such as I now have on hand I also give her
 as much of the Kitchen Ware and furniture as may be deemed
 necessary for her use & convenience Item 5 I give to wife Susan
 two of my choice horses some two horse Haggis & the best Carriage
 & Harness of four cows & calves & four years provisions also as
 many St. Louis & may be deemed necessary for the use of her
 & family for one year Item 6th I give and bequeath to my
 four sons viz William & John L. & Mark L. & Richard Burt
 Four hundred offy Dollars each payable to anyone after my
 Executor is duly authorized to a like amount together with
 one half of my net estate each each one deducting any thing that may
