In the name of God Amen. I Levi Shores of the County of Franklin
and State of Tennessee being well in body but of sound mind
and memory do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament
1st I Will and bequeath to my beloved wife Long Shores during
her life time or widowhood forty acres of the Farm or Tract of
Land on which I now live to be taken off the South side
thereof so as to include my dwelling yard and Garden and all
necessary buildings attached thereto also one negro man Stone
named Joe and one negro woman Stone named Honour also one
man called Bet and one horse called Lancer for the purpose
of cultivating said land also three cows and calves twelve head of hogs
of one year old and three cows and pigs also two plows two
set of quons two hoes & two axes together with all the household
and kitchen furniture except one bed and furniture herein after
named. It is also my wish that my old negro woman Lydia
remain with my wife during her lifetime. It is my
wish that my son Ruben and my daughter Francis and my
Grand daughter Jane Morrison be charged or educated with
of the proceeds of the said forty acres of land after paying all
necessary expenses attending the support of my wife and said
children 2nd It is my Will and desire that the remainder of
my farm be rented out until my children all be come of age
and the proceeds to be applied to paying my said Alfred one
hundred dollars which I owe him 3rd I will and bequeath
to my daughter Sally one negro boy Stone named Andy to her and
the third of her body and should she die without issue it
my wish for the said Lucy Andy to return or demand to my
children then living I also will and bequeath to my daughter
Sally one horse named Emily two cows & calves and one sow
and pigs to her and the third of her body 4th I will and bequeath
to my son Ruben one negro boy named Orange and one horse
named Carl two years old next Spring 5th I will and bequeath to

my Daughter Betty one negro boy named Bob - 6th I still and
 leguath to my Little Daughter Francis one negro girl named
 Mary ~~one~~ and figs " I still and leguath to my Grand
 Daughter Jane Harrison one negro child named mianan and
 one set of furniture & it is my will and desire that at the death
 of my self Mary the said negroes for and after as above leguath
 to her be and to my children and not to be captivated off said
 " It is my will and desire that all my personal estate consisting
 Thomas Hogs of every description together with all my farming
 utensils not otherwise disposed of in this will be sold and the
 proceeds applied to the payment of my just debts " I hereby
 constitute and appoint my joint and several Executors and Richard C
 Holder Executors of this my last will and Testament " In testimony
 whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal at home this 13th day
 of February 1836

 been signed by the Testator who died shortly after the said will
 was written which was done in strict conformity to his
 directions as proved by said calling witnesses and it is
 ordered that said will be recorded and Solomon H. H. H. and
 Richard C. Holder the Executors named in said will come into
 Court their proper persons and renounce the execution of said
