I give and bequeath in manner following to wit that is to say: 1st I will and desire that my wife Eliza Adams have the joint and several of land I now live on including the house and 7000 and two Buds & furniture two cows & calves her choice fine head of hogs all the household and kitchen furniture One ax and all my farming tools & one cotton wheel & corn and my coral more her natural life time 2nd the balance of my estate I will desire to be sold and equally divided between my children and at my wife's decease the part as shall be to her be sold and equally divided as above and Lastly I do constitute and appoint my friend Joseph Smith Executor to this my last will and Testament hereby revoking all other or former wills and Testaments by me here before made.
