 and conveyed to my friend Peter A. Archer my negro slave
 Sally and his three children Sarah Jane and her infant now at
 the house a long named Building and I have to my Executors
 at my death to deliver them & their increase to him 12th
 I appoint my friends Luce P. Huddleston and Agnes B. Huddleston
 Executors of this my will and revoke all other wills which
 may have been made by me. In testimony whereof I have

 Tennessee during my illness in perfect mind
 and memory & calling to mind the mortality of my body
 knowing that it is appointed for all men to die and
 to leave this my last Will & Testament first of all and
 unquestion I give my soul to God who gave it and my body

 resurrection. Secondly as to my worldly Estate wherewith it
 has pleased God to bless me after paying all my great

 the calf to my daughter Nancy Jones I give choice of my
 furred counterpane and my best great trunk and my beds and
 bed clothing. I give to the children of my daughter Louisa
 late of Chelena & Joseph Jones to be equally divided between
 the four families of children all that is otherwise
 killed as a choice Bed quilt to my Grand Daughter
 Elizabeth Jones wife of James A. Jones to Liza J. McChesney
 a certain counterpane that I purchased of her mother and a
 side saddle that I also purchased of her Mother Chloe McChesney
 to my son John Lasater I give my best great bed clothes and to my
 son John Lasater widow I appoint my Executor in fact
 and do not require any security for his Executorship only
 a small dry good and my hand set to my son in Law that
 there may be no argument raised. To the children of my
 daughter Chloe McChesney I give the following property
