

In consideration of my wife Nathan B Phillips -
my wife Polly full authority and do direct that she sell to John Lully the
tract of land on which I now live for one house and one hundred
Dollars to be paid to Joseph Brown and fifty Dollars post me owing
the last in "causes" I give to my wife Polly the house which she
lives in as well as the cause that comes with the house
I direct that my wife sell the place one acre for £1000 and what it is
and such other houses as she may not want for herself and the children
I direct that my wife Polly to sell two acres to Capt. H. C. and
to sell the slaves all that goes to sell my negro and to sell the
loom of shiplane or scipit for himself to sell a big logshed and
the money of all these sales to go to the payment of my debts
and remainder of the money and all the property my wife to have
to maintain the children until her decease

In the name of God Amen & I therefore Shropshire of perfect
mind and memory do by these presents as touching such hold by
goods and chattels wherof I am possessed signifying and making known
this my last will and Testament Renouncing and disannulling all others
hereunto made either written or unscripted and first of all
I recommend my soul to God who gave it and my body to my
Mother Earth knowing that it is appointed once for all men to die
I therefore require my Executor that I have Christian Burial & be
consigned directly to the Earth. Item 1st and next to Burial
item my will that all my great debts and funeral expenses be
discharged of my estate whatever Item 2nd I give and bequeath
to Catherine Shropshire my much beloved wife the negro servant
red, Hannah and her three children Baldwin & ^{red} Harry & Henry
& her three children Jacob Tom & Martin & Sarah also ^{all} my horses
cattle & hogs my household and kitchen furniture as well as all
my wounding tools & all my outstanding debts of every description
whatever for and during her natural life or childhood whom
also I appoint Sole Executor of this my last will and Testament
& in case of death or infirmity to act I appoint my son James
Shropshire Executor in his place Item 3rd I give and bequeath
to my daughter Nancy Shropshire one negro girl named Debbie
to be freed from this slave when made equal with the
rest at a division of her mothers legacy either at her death
or second marriage as I have made no provision in case
to any but her but have accorded her this girl over & when
the Division takes place for her to have that much less
than the rest - Item 4th It is my will that after the death
of my much beloved wife Catherine aforesaid my property
