I have a home plantation at my death at up to such part
as I have given to my wife during her life " and that part
they are to have the portion at her death the other third
of said land I have conveyed to Joseph McCulloch for said
land I charge my sons Archibald & James one thousand
dollars each I give that all the balance of my property
not herein disposed of be sold and all the work of my
children be made equal with my sons I wish charging
them with what they have received and what may be
left after doing so to be equally divided between all my
children " Lastly I nominate constitute and appoint my
son Archibald & James & James McCulloch Executors of
this my last will and Testament " Given under my hand
at all this 12th day of March 1842

during her life then from his Contracts debts & engagements
of every kind after his death then for the use of his said
Elizabeth and her heirs forever. Should said Elizabeth die
without issue then for her heirs on the part of her father
& mother 6th I give and bequeath to my nephew Willis D.
Embury and his heirs forever my Patent Lever Safety Watch
and my shot gun 7th I give and bequeath to Sampson
D. Embury & Clifton R. Embury and their heirs forever the
residue of my Estate herein before disposed of be it of
what kind it may 8th I appoint Clifton R. Embury and
Sampson D. Embury Executors of this my last Will and
