I John Donelson of the County of Transier in Tennessee do here-
 by make or make & publish my last Will & Testament
 hereby revoking all others by me at any time heretofore
 made. I desire that as soon after my death
 as possible my Executor herein after named shall pay all
 my debts out of the money on hand if there is not
 money enough on hand for this purpose I desire
 that my stock or a sufficient thereof shall be sold
 of the proceeds applied to the payment of debts the first
 debt being my funeral expenses. I do not
 direct that after my debts are paid that my wife
 Elateda Donelson shall have during her life all
 the property of my kind & description and of personal notes
 accounts and choses in action to use & dispose
 of as she may think proper she may sell or convey or
 devote other property she is at liberty to use any
