

Oct 10th 1861: I Sallie B. Stampen of the County of Franklin
 and the State of Tennessee being of sound mind & memory but
 suffering with bodily afflictions & knowing the uncertainty
 of life I do make and publish this as my last will & testament
 charging myself all others or former Wills by me at any
 time made. It is my wish that after my death as soon
 as possible all my debts if any of a federal or personal
 shall be paid. I give and bequeath to my Daughter E. L.
 Fryzell Rose Horse my Buggy and Harness my cow Cherry
 and I give her my son called Sweet head and her four
 young Pigs forty pounds Soap, ten barrel of corn one
 sheep the Bacon & birds on hand; I give to my Grand
 daughter D. B. Leary my white faced one side saddle one
 spinning wheel I give her my dog a young sow forty
 pounds of soap and one half the charcoal & birds on hand
 I give to my daughter P. H. whether my Bessie Chase
 and family Bible & Mahon my property is sold my
 Executor for this one hundred dollars in full of the Horse
 Drives to give her my Husband's Will I give to my Grand
 daughter M. H. Strande my truffer called Rose and the
 motherless calf also one side saddle one spinning
 wheel and cords and a work robe I give to my son D. C.
 Stampen my double barrel Gun the property left by
 daughter Eliza Stampen I wish my two Granddaughters
 Sallie B. Stampen & Mary H. Strande whose in the way
 I have already supplied between them Sallie to have
 the red bed spread & furniture which I have given her
 and I give to her my Black Bedstead Bed & furniture in
 place of some of the clothes I made use of the dress
 & I have divided between them all my best clothing
 table ware I will divide among my children before I
 die all my other property not disposed of by this will
 on hand at the time of my death I wish my Executor
 to see and after paying my debts and funeral expenses
 and the one hundred dollars to my daughter P. H. Strande
 to divide the balance equally between all my children
 should I should also give to Elvira & Thine G. Stampen
 Sallie that calf D. C. Stampen E. L. Fryzell P. H. Strande & by
 the Grandchildren Sallie H. Strande & H. H. Strande the two Grand
 children to receive one one share & Sallie that calf
 portion at her death to be given to my daughter E. L. Fryzell
 or to her children in case she should die before Sallie
 that is the property given or the portion that may be
 coming to my daughter and grand children I give to them
 for they own and I bequeath to the said Executor my
 son D. C. Stampen Executor of this my last will & testament
 I being advised I here repeat set my hand affixed my
 seal this the tenth day of March in the year of our Lord one

I Delila Green being of sound mind & disposing memory
 do make & publish this my Last Will & Testament. I first
 1st I want all my just debts paid 2nd All my beds & bed
 clothes & dishes & all my household & all the furniture
 to be equally divided between my dear brothers to wit
 William Henderson & M. & Peter Green except one set of silver
 table & one set of silver tea spoons which I give to
 Peter Green for which he is to account to the other heirs
 3rd I give to the said Peter Green my barrel horse or
 belly horse & above his interest herein after relinquished
 by me & I give my saddle to my niece Mary & John
 Daughters of John J. Green 4th All the balance of my estate
 both real & personal is to be sold by my Executor
 at public or private sale as he may deem best
 the proceeds on one & the realty on one & two years
 and he is hereby directed not to incur the expenses
 of procuring a decree of any Court for said sale
 5th I direct that the proceeds of said sale to be equally
 divided between my brothers & Jane & Green the widow
 Lillian Green & the children of Albert Green & the child
 of Felix Green to one share each that is all my
 Green's children one share & Delila Green's child one
 share 6th The share or interest relinquished to John J.
 Green is for the sole & separate use of him & his
 family known & not liable to the debts or contracts
 of the said John J. Green Here before in check or
 hereafter to be received the said John J. Green is hereby
 appointed to control said share & interest but is
 not to dispose of the principal. I hereby nominate
 Canastota & appoint my brother William Green
 my sole Executor to this my last will & Testament
 This Jan 4 1870
