I Samuel Henderson now of the County of Franklin and
State of Tennessee do make and appoint this to be my last
will and Testament stand. I desire begin with my
Daughter Susan Spyles as much as will make together
with your hundred and Twenty five Dollars already advanced
to her the sum of Five hundred and Twenty five Dollars
being the amount of what I have advanced to my Daughter
Tally Gillaspie. I also desire give and bequeath to my
Daughter Sally Rains as much as will make together
with your hundred and Sixty Dollars already advanced to her amount
to Five hundred and Seventy five Dollars equal to what
I have advanced as aforesaid to my Daughter Fanny
Gillaspie. I also give devise and bequeath to my daughter
Socia Estee as much as will make together those hundred
Dollars already advanced amount to the sum of Five
hundred and Twenty five Dollars the sum advanced to my
Daughter Fanny Gillaspie and I also give devise and bequeath
to my Daughter Socia Estee a negro woman Slave named
Bettie to have and possess the said Slave during her life not
subject to alienation by her husband or in being whelped
to his hounds etc but to her own proper use behoof and to her
own chaire use and in her own right. I also give devise
and bequeath Sam Henderson Tenant to my Daughter Elizabeth
Dixon one negro woman Slave named Estee also one bed
and furniture also a loom with all the tackle there belonging
the said Slave bed and Loom estimated at Four hundred and
Sixty Two Dollars which together with Twenty Dollars
already advanced amounts to Four hundred and Sixty Two Dollars
and I do further give and bequeath unto the said Elizabeth
Dixon Eighty Eight Dollars to make the aforesaid bequeath equal
to what I have advanced to my Daughter Fanny Gillaspie
I also give devise and bequeath to my Daughter Julia

Hundredd Five hundred and twenty five Dollars together
with a bed and Bedding furniture and also one Large Dine
Silver Tea Spoons and Spinning Wheel. I also give Denise
and Leueat to my Grand Daughter Cheekless of my son
Richard Hudson died Two Hundredd Dollars each to in case
of any of my said Grand Children should decease before their
attaining the age of maturity I will give and bequeath that the
Legacy hereby bequeathed shall survive equally to the
surviving issue off of such deceased legatee if any but if
not then as aforesaid to the surviving survivors as if all
of my Grand Daughters should decease without issue and
during their age Denise and Leueat the sum hereby given
denied and bequeathed to my said Grand Daughters to their
eldest My Daughter some relief of said Richard Hudson
It being my intention that these special legacies to my grand
Daughter shall survive successively in case of the death of either
to the surviving equally to be divided and on failure of issue to
their children. I also give Denise and Leueat to my son Pleasant
Hudson and need and want of a tract of land situated in
the County of Boone known by the name of the Post Oak Spring
tract and further as a suit is now pending relative to the title
of said tract of land my intention and will is that should the
title to said tract of land be adjudged to me that the same
should be and I hereby Denise and Leueat the same to the said Pleasant
Hudson in fee simple but if the said title should be adjudged
against me I hereby bequeath to my said son Pleasant
Hudson the warrant or certificate that may be obtained
in his name for said grant and I further desire Denise and Leueat
to my said son Pleasant one negro boy called Allen but
this Allen bequeath is only to trust and to be held in the course
of his failing in the suit now pending relative to said Land
also Denise and Leueat to my son Pleasant Hudson on
a said warrant issued in the name of Charles Gordon for
four hundred acres it being now understood that my son
Pleasant Hudson is to sustain the expense of prosecuting
said suit and not to make the same a charge against my
estate however the said suit may be said Hudson to be
determined. I also give & more and bequeath to my son Alfred
Hudson the tract of land on which I have lately resided
in Franklin County containing three hundred acres to hold to
him & his assigns in fee simple and I further desire and bequeath
that if my son Alfred should decease before he attains the
age of twenty one and without issue that then the said tract
of land shall be my Executors to him after named be sold
and the proceeds of the sale be equally divided between all
my Daughters and in case of their decease with issue
that their respective shares shall descend to their respective
issue in equal proportions in right of Representation.

I also will devise legate and direct by this my Testament
that during the minority of my son Alfred my Executors
herein after named shall rent the said lot devised to him
of land for the longest annual sum of money that it will yield
thirty Dollars thereof is to be applied to the use of my daughter Julia
so long as she remains sole or until she attains the age of
Twenty one at being my intention that this provision for my
said Daughter is not made out of the profits of said land but
determine our marriage or at Twenty one years of her age
as aforesaid. I also devise legate and direct that a sum
whatever now in the possession of my son Pleasant Henderson
left by my Executors as aforesaid sold and the money arising
from the sale thereof be applied to & expended in the
sustentations and education of my children Alfred & Julia
during their minority. I also devise legate and direct that
my Executors herein after named shall as soon as practicable
cause all debts now due & owing to me to be collected
and distributed according to the specifications herein before directed
at being my will and intention that all the remaining Legacies
herein specified shall with the sum heretofore advanced & profited
to them respectively bequeath to the same advanced to my Daughter
Julia & except my Executors just satisfying out of my
debts first collected all debts due from me to others
I also will and direct that my four slaves Dick, Ben Adam &
Vice be by my Executors freed from the long and sum
of money that the will bring and that twenty Dollars of said
sum be in addition to the provisions already made applied
to the sustentations of my Daughter Julia during the time she
may continue sole at being my will and intention that this
provision with that heretofore directed in this Testament be an
annual allowance. And I further desire (Daniel Sam Henderson)
direct & bequeath that my Executors cause such property
as is herein not specifically devised & bequeathed to be sold
on a moderate credit for that and the amount when collected
to be distributed amongst my children according to the
provisions of this will and I further desire and bequeath
to my daughter Julia Henderson a negro boy slave -
named Trigil. And I further desire & bequeath & direct
that in case the title to the said tract of land herein
before devised to my son Pleasant Henderson shall be decided
in my favor that the negro boy all be together with my
slaves Dick & Ben & Adam Vice shall at the expiration
of five years from my decease be sold for cash on a credit of
twelve months and the amount of said sales when collected
after discharging debts that we be due from me together with
the Legacies herein specified shall go in a course of distribution
to all my children now living and those above or to the representation
of such of my children as may decease before this clause of my

Will is executed in such manner that this child or slave
receive such propertys as his parents could have by virtue
of this Will Claimed. And I do further direct & command
and appy that my negro boy Allen shall inherit the said
sum directed of said Moses altho the residence of my Son
Alfred and my Daughter Julia subject to their justicione
It being my Will that the all my property being valued that is
not held in speece carry unvalued and divided in this
Statement shall be distributed according to the intencion
herein before expressed that is among my children now living
equally or their representataries if any of them should decease
before the provisions of this Will can be effected. I also give
and bequeath to my son Alfred my riding horse with
saddle and Bridle or such riding horse as I may be possessed
at my decease and I do by this my last Will and Testament
appoint Johnathan Spangler, Philetus Henderson & John McHolland
executors of my last Will and Testament, and I hereby cancel &
revoke all Wills, Deeds, gifts and bequests contained in any former
Wills, Deeds or bequests made or executed by me

In the Name of God Omnipotent. I Ephraim Davis of the County
of Trousdale and State of Tennessee being weak of body but of
sound and perfect mind and memory blessed God for the same
but considering the mortality of my body that it is appointed
for all men once to die do this the Thirtieth day of December
One thousand Eight hundred and Sixty six make and ordain
this my last Will and Testament. First I do command my
Soul to almighty God who gave it and my body of it in my
decrease to be decently buried without embalming that that it
will by the power of God be raised again and moreover
to live. And as touching those worldly goods whi ch God
has given me I dispose of them in the following manner
First I give and bequeath to my son James one half of the
tract of land which I now have to be divided into two
equal parts by a line running North and South James to
have the Northeast I also hold to my beloved wife Anne
the other half of the said tract of land lying the East and
west its improvements also all the household and Kitchen furniture
