

In the name of God Amen I Solomon K Goodman of the
 State of Tennessee and County of Davidson being sound in heart
 but being in perfect mind and memory do make and ordain
 this my last will and Testament in the first place I will my
 soul to God who gave it me. my body to be buried in a Christian
 manner as to my worldly goods I dispose of it in the following
 manner the first place I give unto my beloved wife Elizabeth
 Goodman my negro boy Joe and my negro boy Lewis two beds and
 furniture one brass bed furniture one Bureau and several more
 of my & Corry's one third part of my stock of horses a stock of
 George & Thomas furniture half a dozen chairs the crop on
 hand reserving the Cotton Crop for the payment of my debts
 to her and her heirs forever. Provided she raises over children
 without charge. I give to Daughter Eliza Adams four doctors
 in addition to what she has already received. I give unto
 my Daughter Robert James four hundred dollars in notes
 received of Thomas King to be paid out by my Executors in
 the purchase of a negro girl for said Robert in addition to
 what she has already received to her and her heirs forever.
 I give unto my son Madison Goodman my negro boy Manuel
 his riding horse one bed and furniture his whiskey & account
 one cow and calf to him and his heirs forever. I give unto my
 son Solomon Goodman a negro boy Jas (a coat his hand-
 mather gave him one bed and furniture one cow and calf to
 him and his heirs forever together with one hundred dollars
 I give unto my Daughter Mary Goodman a negro girl
 Caroline one bed and furniture the several more coat
 one cow and calf her choice of Tennesse and one hundred
 dollars to her and her heirs forever is my desire that the
 lands wherein I now live be divided between my wife
 and two sons Madison & Solomon equally my wife to be
 entitled to her part during her natural life the other two
 to be divided between my two sons but Provided that there
 should come any debts come against the estate that cannot
 be otherwise discharged than out of the whole go to discharge
 the same to them and their heirs forever it is my desire that
 my two negro men Henry & John be hired out by
 Executors for the purpose of raising money for the payment of
 any debts that may come against the estate provided that
 there should need be sufficient there both to be used by
 my Executors to the best advantage to answer the purpose
 my old negro man Henry there on the Plantation to be supported
 & passed his mistress I further give unto my wife
 two cows and calves and the stock of sheep and fifty dollars
 in money loan and I will to her and her heirs forever
 and further I bequeath that I appoint Poruphet Herndon
 Executor and my wife Elizabeth Goodman executrix to carry
 into effect this my last will and Testament. Witness

In the name of God Amen; I Morgant Jones being much
indisposed in body and not knowing that I shall ever
recover my health again. And having a desire to dispose
of my worldly goods which the Lord hath blessed me with
to my own satisfaction do hereby constitute and make this
my last will and Testament as follows viz 1st It is my
request that all of my just debts ^{shall} be paid this being
done I 2nd give and bequeath to the wife of John Drake
deceased one dollar three pence 3^{rdly} I give and bequeath
to Mary Storace one dollar and pence 4^{thly} I give and
bequeath to Benjamin Jones one thousand Dollars 5^{thly} I give
and bequeath to John Adams & William B. Jones the balance
After Justice is satisfied for the trouble he has been at with me
of a legacy due me in the State of Tennessee a Patent County
from John Buchanan my father's debt to his equally
divided between them for which I have given Joseph Joseph
Drake a power of Attorney to collect for me the same when
collected to paid over to William B. Jones and Thiriam B. Jones
who is by these presents authorized to receive the same
and I also appoint them as Executors to this my last will and
Testament given under my hand and seal this 22nd day of
October one thousand eight hundred and twenty six
