In consideration of the careful attention and support given and supplied to me and to the money and supplied to me during my natural life I will devise and bequeath to my Son in Law W. B. Mahan & his wife Harriet during the life of my said daughter Harriet all the real estate and personal property of every kind the description of which I may hereinafter describe in my said will. At the death of my said daughter Harriet the real estate and personal property shall be equally divided between all my children or their representatives in their proper proportions. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 1st day of July 1866 signed sealed and concluded in our presence as follows: P. L. Estie

County Court August Term 1866: Then the last will & testament of Thomas Garner dec'd was presented to Court for probate & duly proven by the Oaths of P. L. Estie the Justices sitting thereunto ordered to be recorded:

Henry Hunt do make and publish this my last will & testament as follows: I leave my body to the Lord and my soul to God who gave it and after my funeral expenses are paid my desire is that all my just debts be paid by my execution and of any money that may come into this hands of mine I will give is that my undivided interest with the tract of land that my father Henry Hunt died seized and possessed amounting to two hundred and twenty acres be equally divided between Benjamin F. Smith Lewis and S. Smith Elizabeth Smith W. M. Smith my nephews & nieces. I give to Lewis & Smith one half the land and one half to Elizabeth Smith my daughter and my wife the said Elizabeth
