 and saddle and the horse to be furnished or raised out of my
 property at the discretion of my wife and all my girls
 a horse one cow and calf bed and furniture as they come of age
 and what I have given to my children now grown I want
 no charge made against her for that and if my wife should
 die and there any children under age not to school them
 of them one hundred dollars to be raised at the discretion
 of my Executors then at the death of my wife and I have
 all of my property: Bonds notes and accounts to be equally
 divided between my children without distinction by
 a sale of all the property without exception at the discretion
 of my Executors. And I do leave my wife Susan Horton
 and my son Thomas Horton and Big John Horton my
 lawful Executors to sign and seal in presence of

Polly Sullivan. The remaining of the ^{personal} property consisting of Corn and
one half of Guineas tools and lot of turners tools and other articles that
are not required for the immediate use of the family. I wish to
be sold with the least possible delay and the money therefrom
put to interest which interest I wish to be appropriated to the
use of the said Elizabeth and the above named children. The
family I wish to be equally divided among the above named
children. It is my desire that the said Elizabeth shall have
that tract of land that I purchased of Capt. Williams of the
adjoining at George Allen Brooks tract of land lying on upper
Brauns River during her natural life or widowhood at her
death I wish the said land sold for cash and equally divided
among the surviving children. I have about five hundred
dollars in notes and accounts that are due I wish them
collected and invested in the same manner as the money

acres of Land situate by the River place to my three sons
