stock of geese two oxen one iron with a one side saddle
one fox wheel one cotton shell and cords. also I desire my
wife to have a child part of the money 2^d my daughter Sarah
Hart to have the hewn more 1 cow and calf one feather bed
and furniture to make her equal with the rest of the children
also to have an equal part of my estate remaining with the rest
