 mind and memory blessed be almighty God for the same do make
 and publish this my last will and Testament in manner and form
 following that is to say First I give and bequeath unto my
 beloved wife Elizabeth Moore the following property to wit. One
 negro woman named Sarah a child named Hannah a boy the name
 of George a boy the name of David also one boy by the name of
 Isaac Son 2nd Daniel that Anna Graham has a negro girl
 named Dora during her natural life then to revert to the
 heirs of her body. Item the 3rd I will that my wife as above
 named has the residue and remaining part of my property
 real, and personal at my death to have and enjoy
 in full and peaceable possession of the same during her natural
 life and after her decease the above named property is to be equally
 divided between the following children to wit Archibald Moore
 Lodowick Moore Archibald Moore Martha Jones Purnell
 Nicholson Ann Graham Sarah Hodgson Mary Connor to be equally
 divided amongst them I do also will and bequeath unto my
 beloved daughter Elizabeth Hodgson a negro girl by the
 name of Mary and my son girl by the name of Jane with my
 Grand daughter Duff Melus is to be considered their legacy
 and full share out of my real and personal estate and that
 they are entitled to no more ~~part~~ of my estate whatsoever
 I also nominate and appoint my beloved sons Archibald Moore
 Lodowick Moore and Archibald Moore or any two of them
 my Executors to this my last will and Testament disavowing
 and revoking all former wills by me made ratifying this
 and only this to be my last and my last will and Testament
 the 8th day of December 1821

In the name of God Amen. I William Bonet being in my
 right mind and perfect sense do declare this to be my last will
 and Testament do dispose of my estate in the following manner.
 First I give and bequeath to my daughter Lydia Price one negro
 woman Esther I do give and bequeath to my daughter Jane Jones
 one negro girl named Jim I also give and bequeath to my daughter
 Nancy one negro girl named Bob one cow & calf Bad and
 furniture I also give and bequeath to my daughter Polly
 one negro boy named Job one cow and calf Bad and
 furniture and I also order and direct if either of my daughters
 Nancy or Pollys negroes should die before they come of age

that they may be made a hole out of my estate and if
 either of my Daughters Nancy or Polly should die that their
 negro return to my estate again. If they should die with
 out any heirs and my fine son David Sandage Richard
 Hunsford Granville each of them as they come of age to
 receive a horse and a saddle the balance of my estate by
 my negroes that I own Charles Charles Tiler Rose these all
 my stock of cattle and horses and logs and growing interests
 here and there I have my wife Morion
 cannot during her natural life or widowhood and at her death
 or forfeiture my fine son David Sandage Richard Hunsford
 & Granville may receive each of them the balance
 of my estate and then the balance of my estate to be equally
 divided among my children. My James Thomas William
 Susan Lydia Jane David Sandage Richard Hunsford Granville
 Nancy Polly. I also order and direct that my son David and
 Sandage and my wife Morion to be my Executors. Given under
 my hand and seal this 11th of November 1820.

 and State of Tennessee finding the decay of nature working on me
 must and ordain this my last will and Testament that is to say my
 body to the earth from whence it came and my soul to God that
 gave it all my and worldly goods that it hath pleased the
 God to bless me with I give and devise as followeth I give
 them and bequeath unto my loving wife Mary Goodman my
 Land and plantation on the east side of the river with four
 negroes to till it. My George Sebra & Robert to be and
 the heirs forever I give to my son Solomon R Goodman
 my coal fire iron and above what he has had to him and
 his heirs forever I give to my son William Goodman
 the Land and plantation where he now lives by the name
 of the Logan Place to him and his heirs forever. I give to my
 Daughter Abigail Burrow one cow and calf over and above
 what she has had to her and her heirs forever and lastly I give
 to my wife Mary Goodman all the remainder of my stock
 of horses cattle sheep and hog with all the house hold furniture
 my description to be and her heirs forever and all the
 remainder in this is my last and best will of my body
 Admini 1819. I also certify and confirm this and the others to
 be my last will and Testament
