County and State of Tennessee being in a low estate of health
but of a sound mind and memory for which I thank God
and failing to mind the uncertainty of life and the mortality
of the body and being desirous to dispose of the temporal Estate
the Lord has been pleased to take me with so much
ordain this my last Will and Testament in the following
manner that is to say: 1st. Devise that the tract of land
I now live on and all my personal estate in sight and
be at the disposal of my well beloved wife Polly Crawford
to raise my family during her natural life or widow-
hood and as ~~desire~~ of my children in any that she give
them of my personal estate as she may think right and
at her decease my land divided between my two sons
George and Alexander and all my personal Estate be equally
divided amongst my female children, and I do
hereby and constitute my wife Polly Crawford & my
brother friend Samuel Reid my Executors of this my
last Will and Testament. Not being able to write in
testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal
this 20th day of Dec 1814
