 last Will and Testament with my friend William H. Storch
 in witnesses whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal
 the day and year above mentioned 2

In the name of God Amen. I William Lloyd of the County
 of Madison & State of Tennessee Being of sound mind and
 memory do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in
 manner & form as follows: I give and bequeath my soul to God & my
 body to be decently buried Infirmities. I give and bequeath unto
 my son Alexander Lloyd that part of the tract of land I live on
 that lies nearest my plantation for two hundred acres (be the
 same more or less) Beginning at an Irony Partridge and corner
 and my Nor east corner running South forty five degrees West
 with my line so far that a parallel line with my other line
 South 45 East as line run within two poles of the upper fence
 as it now stands it have his line & assigns forever I also give
 to my said son Alexander my negro man and it have his
 line & assigns forever I also give him one half forever. I give
 I give and bequeath to my son Elisha Lloyd that part of the tract
 of land I live on that lies South west of the same as it
 now stands running a parallel line from my land line
 through the middle of the said land so as to strike a black
 oak in said land. Thus as to run parallel with the
 Lloyd's line as above South 45 East. To him his line and
 assigns forever. I also give my son Elisha my negro man
 George to him his assigns forever. I also do give him one
 half forever. I give and bequeath to my Grandson William
 & Elisha Lloyd sons of David Lloyd deceased all the tract of
 or parcel of land lying between Alexander and Elisha Lloyd
 part as above described, to be equally divided between them
 share and share alike, and in case of the death of one or the
 other the survivor to enjoy the whole of him and his line forever
 provided in it death should take place before he or they come of age
 but it is to be expressly understood that my Grand Daughter
 Nancy Lloyd sister to said William & Elisha shall have such

of the produce of said land as my Executors may think sufficient for
 her maintenance till she comes of age or marries. Item I do
 respect my negro man Reubin to give and bequeath him to my
 said grandsons their heirs & assigns forever on the following terms
 & condition (viz) said negro to work for said children (viz) William
 Elushe & Nancy till she comes of age or marries and also for his
 father till then when said Nancy comes of age said William
 and Elushe or the surviving one in the case of the death of the
 others, to pay said Nancy on third the value of said negro at
 such reasonable time and value as my Executors may think just
 and equitable as respects my negro woman Lamer & Betty my
 wish is that they live during their lives on the land above
 named to said William Elushe my Grandsons there with the
 help of Reubin as aforesaid to work for themselves and said Grand
 Children under the eye & direction of my Executors till the
 said children come of age and should what happen in the course
 of human life that the said Lamer or Betty should by reason
 of age be come useless or unable to work I do assign it on my
 said Grand Children & on my Executors not to let them
 suffer but to support them on the above condition I give and
 bequeath the said negro woman to my said Grand Children
 in equal share or to the survivor or survivors (as the case may be)
 to his or their heirs & assigns forever. Item I also give and bequeath
 to the said William Elushe one young black horse & Farming
 utensils to attend their land with. I also give them one pair
 & two yearlings each also two ~~mares~~ heifers apiece one
 bed and furniture & Elushe one Gray Goat also a row of pigs
 each & sufficient quantities of meat & Grain to support them & the
 negro one year & all my household furniture not otherwise
 disposed of above and share alike. I will also they have privilege
 of the well and eating fruit out of the orchard & the Cabin
 & now live in & keepy. Item I give and bequeath my
 Grand Daughter Nancy & her one cow and sheep two ewes
 & two weathers one bed two dresses in addition to the
 above & Reubin to take care of her stock till she comes of age
 and feed them out of her part of the produce as above named
 Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Rebecca Layse one
 fourth part of the money I may have at death deducting
 twenty dollars therefrom I leave her. Item I give and bequeath
 to my Daughter John Moore a negro woman named Hulet
 & her increase to her & her heirs assigns forever & I also give
 her one fourth part of the money I may have at my death
 deducting one hundred and twenty dollars therefrom that she
 has already read - Item I give and bequeath her also one
 third of my live stock not otherwise disposed of. Item I give
 and bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Tubbs one fourth of the
 money I may have at my death deducting therefrom one
 hundred & twenty dollars I leave her husband. I give and

bequeath to the heirs of the body of Sarah Spickard deceased
one fourth of the money I may have at my death deducting
three hundred and sixty five dollars therefrom that I leave them
father to be divided among them or their survivors of them in
equal shares then I give & bequeath to the children of my son
Freeman Lloyd second the sum of five dollars each then I give
and bequeath to the Elk River Baptist Church one acre of ground
to include the meeting house in the center provided said
church should become extinct said acre shall next be left
to my son Elisha Lloyd then I also will that one acre
of ground be set apart for ever for a burying ground at the
opposite place of burial then I also give to grandson William
son of David Lloyd the oldest of the gray colts then I also
give my wagon & gear for the use of the plantation &
also will that my negro man Woulam be permitted to
keep or sell his property as may suit him then I that
should there be any money stock or other property left over
and above that already bequeathed that it be equally divided
among my surviving daughters. Lastly I do hereby appoint
my my sons Alon and Elisha Lloyd sole Executors of this my
last will and Testament ratifying this & revoking all former
ones made by me. In witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and seal this 4th day of February 1821
