of Franklin & State of Tennessee Being of sound mind and

manner & form as follows: By / I bequeath my soul to God & my
body to be decently buried Deponents I give and bequeath unto
my Son Alexander Floyd that part of the tract of land & live on
that lies next my plantation for two hundred acres (be the
same more or less) Beginning at an Hickory Bushy is old corner
and my Northeast corner running South Westly five Acres there
with my line so far that a fowle line with my other line
South & East as will run within two poles of the upper fence
as it now stands to him his heirs & executors forever. I also give
to my said son Alexander my negro man and to him his
heirs & executors forever. I also give him one bed frame "dim.
2' 6" and a pealeathet to my son Elasha Floyd that part of the tract
of land I live on that lies South west of the same as it
now stands running a fowle line from my head line
through the middle of the said land so as to strike a black
Oak in said land I own. There is no as to run parallel with the

George to him his executors forever. I also do give him one

Gray and bequeath him to my said grandsons their heirs & assigns forever for the forthcoming times & condition (say) said negro to work for said children (say) William Elihu & Nancy till she comes of age or marries and also for his mother until then when said Nancy comes of age said William and Elihu or the surviving one (in the case of the death of the others) to pay said Nancy on third the value of said negro at such reasonable sum and value as my Executors may think just and equitable as respects my negro woman Anna B. Pitty now this is that they live during this time on the land above described & said William Elihu my Grandsons there with the help of Rubin as aforesaid & work for themselves & said Grand Children under the eye & direction of my Executors till the said children come of age and should happen in the course of human events that the said Anna or Pitty should by reason of age become useless or unable to work I do moreover upon my said Grand children & on my Executors not to let them suffer want to support them on the above condition I give and bequeath all the said negro woman Anna my said Grand Children & if equal share or to the survivors or survivors (as the case may be) to his or their heirs & assigns forever. Item 4: also give and bequeath to the said William Elihu one young black horse & driving utensils to attend their said work. I also give them one cow & two yearlings each also two ~~sheep~~ ^{sheep} two others apiece one bed and furniture & clothes one gray coat also a bow & pigs each & sufficient quantity of meat & grain to support them & the negroes one year & race every household furniture not otherwise disposed of done and stored aside. I leave also they have freedom of the kitchen and eating room out of the orchard & the cabin & now live in & occupy Item 5: I give and bequeath my Grand Daughter Nancy Lloyd one cow and sheep two ewes & two lambs one sheep two colts in addition to the above & Rubin to take care of her stock till she comes of age and feed them out of her part of the produce as above intimated Item 6: I give and bequeath all my Daughters Rebecca Hayes or fourth part of the money I may have at death deducted twenty dollars therefore & husband: Item 7: I give and bequeath to my Daughter Jane Moore a negro woman named Hobbs & her increase to her & her heirs assigns forever & also give her one forth part of the money I may have at my death deducting one hundred and twenty dollars therfrom that at the has already read - Item 8: I give and bequeath her also one third of my live stock not otherwise disposed of Item 9: I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Tubb one forth of the money I may have at my death deducting therefore one hundred & twenty dollars & leave her husband. of ground be set apart forever for a burying Ground at the
present place of burial item I also give to Grandson William
son of David Lloyd the old lot of the gray cattle item I also
will my wagon & gears for the use of the plantation &
also will that my negro man Wm. can be permitted to
keep or sell things property as may suit him. item I shall
see there be any necessary stock or other property left over
and above that already bequeathed that it be equally divided
among my surviving children. Lastly I do hereby appoint
my son's also and is that of Lloyd late Executives of this my
last Will and Testament ratifying this & revoking all former
