and State of Lancashire knowing that it appointed for all man on a to die
mindful of my departure from this mortal state and the happiness
of the offspring of my body that I may leave behind and bring an
sound mind and memory do make and publish this my last
Will and Testimony hereby revoking all former shills In the first
place it is my will after my decease that my body be
buried in the dust from whence it came and that
my funeral charges and just debts be paid by my
Executors herein after named out of my estate Then it is my
will and I do hereby give and bequeath unto my present wife
Jemimah Griffin otherwise called Jemimah McCoy now
living with me all my live stock of Domestic Animals of
every kind and all my Household furniture of every said kind
all my Farming utensils of every kind and the use and occupation
of my Plantation wherein I now live I have after hired my
son General in fees all of which said estates her
deceased husband it is my will that she possess and enjoy and
affit my decease estate and continue in possession of the same
dust the use and benefit thereof during her natural life or
widowhood only for the purpose of reasonably providing for and
schooling & Educating my my three children herein after
named by her and that she have a right to sell and dispose of
any of the personal property above mentioned or lease the land
when she may find it necessary to do so for her own
use and the benefit of the said children and at her death
or marriage the said property to her alone devised or the
proceeds thereof then remaining to be equally divided by my
Executors between my three children above named to viz
Mahala General & Linda which I have had born to me
by the said Jemimah to whom I do further will and bequeath
the absolute right of all my estate both real and personal
in manner following viz I do give and bequeath unto
my said Daughter Mahala Griffin otherwise called Mahala
McCoy my negro boy named Bimby and my negro girl
named Dina to be hers absolutely when she arrives of full
age or at her marriage and to descend to her heirs forever
But until then they are to work for her or to be hired out for
her benefit under the direction of her mother if she lives
and continues unmarried if not under the direction
of my Executors or her guardian if she has one and the
increase of said negro girl and to be hers in her manner
and I do give and bequeath unto my said son General Griffin other
wise called General McCoy and to his heirs forever in full the
right title and interest to the tract of land wherein I now
live containing about 270 acres hereby died of Canning an infant
General John Coffey to him but it is my will as above stated that
my said wife Jemimah have the possession and benefit of the same

jointly with him for the purpose living on it herself and
providing for and educating the said three children during
her life or widowhood out of the property of the land and the
other estates subject to that use as herein mentioned and I do
hereby give and bequeath unto my said son General my
negro woman named Wilson to be absolutely his wife during
at the age of twenty one and twenty two and his heirs forever
but such he deserves at that age the said negro woman to work
for him or be hired out for his benefit under the direction
of his master if she should live and remain unmarried if
not under the directions of my Executor or his Guardian
if he should have one and in like manner I do will to my
said son General a negro boy named Jacob if I should
purchase him from Col. John Griffin before my death if not
it is my will that said General at my death have the sum
of Four Hundred Dollars in Cash instead of said negro to be
spent over on Delinquent and were secured until he arrives at the
age of twenty one and the use of the negro Jacob or the
allowance of the \$400- as the case may be to be applied as above
directed about Wilson and I do also give and bequeath unto
my said Daughter Lucinda Griffin otherwise named Lucinda
Haley my negro woman named Hester & known here as
from this time and her child Esther and my negro boy named
Kitt take her absolutely when she arrives Lawful age or
at her marriage and to demand it her heirs forever but
until her lawful age or marriage as it is my will in like
manner to direct with regard to the negro above named
to whom also I will and direct that that the same named
negro should to Lucinda or to work for her or be hired out
for her benefit under the direction of his master if she live
and continue unmarried if not under the directions of
my Executor or his guardian if she have one and further
I do will and bequeath to my said Son General another tract
of land adjoining the one wherupon I now live containing a wood
of One Thousand & fifty acres which I bought of Benjamin
Johnston to have and to hold to said General at his heirs and
assigns forever and subject to the same use until General
is Twenty one years old as the other property is if my
wife my wife should think it necessary and I do further think
that all the residue of my estate not herein above bequeathed
both real and personal which which may be at my death
shall be sold by my Executors and the proceeds thereof equally
Divided among my self Junius and his said three
children aforesaid and applied as the property bequeathed is
above directed to be done and it is further my will that
if either of my said three children above named should die
before they are twenty one years old or before they have
Lawful heirs that avert the estate herein devised to them shall

immediately or not in and belong to the surviving two of the said children and in case two of the three said children should die before they are Twenty one years old or before they have lawful heirs then shall all the estate herein devised to them shall be immediately or not in and belong to the surviving one of the said three children and in case all three of the above named children should die without lawful heirs it is my will that the estate herein stand thus share be and is set in Solomon Griffin John Griffin and my said wife Jamima each to have an equal third part thereof upon the death of the last of all three of my alone named children Mahala General & Luenda without heirs and the last mentioned third part of my said said wife in that event provided is to descend to the Solomon Griffin and John Griffin upon her death or future marriage and it is also my will and desire that my said three children Mahala, General, & Luenda whom I have hereby made my heirs and successors be well raised and provided for and have each a good Christian Education out of the property of my estate above allotted for that use and the support of my wife Jamima and I do hereby nominate ordain and appoint my trusty friend Josiah Bonham & John Frame of Lincoln County the executors of this my last Will and Testament. I William Lindley of the County of Franklin and State of Tennessee being weak of body but sound in mind doth make & ordain this my last will and Testament that is to say first. I will that out of my estate my four wards Michael, Robert Jane and Obediah Archibald be paid the sum of one hundred one Dollars and twenty five Cents East as soon as it can be raised out of my estate to be paid into the hands of their future guardian for their use till they lawfully come of age or as great as the money can be collected from him. And secondly I will that the balance of my estate be sold to the highest bidder and when the family gets out to Indiana Territory and then be equally divided between my children that is to say William first Alyah, Aliza, John Sally & Jacob and wife Martha have an equal part with with my children above named.

It is to be observed that William is to have his part as soon as it is collected and further I do hereby nominate & appoint and constitute my son John Lindley sole executor of this my estate last will and Testament &c revoking all altho' wills made by me. In witness whereof I have hereunto
