memory and considering the uncertainty of death and the uncertainty
of life do hereby make and declare this my last Will
and Testament in manner and form as follows: First I
wish that all my just debts be faithfully paid. Secondly
I bequeath to my wife Mary Kelly during her natural life
a certain negro woman named Rachel and her two children and
all the household & kitchen furniture which remains after
my decease and at her death I wish the whole of this property
to be sold on a post sufficient to raise the sum of one
hundred and forty two dollars and that sum to be equally
divided between my Grand children namely Selma P.
Lucia and John P. Kelly Benjamin Kelly third and of any
over plus remains I wish to give the sum of five dollars
each of my Daughters in addition to what I have given
them heretofore namely to my Daughter Mary Ann Bonfield
the sum of five dollars to my Daughter Alice Bonfield five
dollars to my Daughter Rachel McCalister five dollars to my
Daughter Nancy McCalister five dollars and to each of my
five dollars I wish and if any over plus remains of all this
or any other personal property I wish it equally divided between

my two sons Durham Kelley and Lewis Kelley also I give to my
son Durham Kelley a certain negro boy named Luningford to my
son Lewis Kelley I give a certain negro boy named Jack and
lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my two sons Durham
Kelley and Lewis Kelley my whole and sole sole Executors and removing all
others I do hereby certify this to be my last will and Testament In
witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this eighteenth
day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and twenty four Signed sealed and delivered in presence of us and
we saw the Testator and ratify and acknowledge

negro boy named Jackson in addition to two others heretofore
given one a girl named Frank and a boy named Richard Fifth
I give and bequeath to my fourth daughter Sarah B
Hedington a negro girl named Mary Smith I give and
bequeath unto my beloved wife Sarah Palmer all the real and
personal estate during her natural
life Fifthly I give and bequeath unto my daughter Eliza Palmer
Margaret Heddington Eliza Palmer Hannah Heddington
