 Knight of the County of Transylvania in the State of Tennessee being
 of sound and disposing mind do make this my last will and
 Testament to wit. I will that all my property
 both real and personal of every description be collected
 together and remain as I hope it at my death and to be
 divided as the immediate control and management of my Sons
 James & John Knight and my friend Benjamin Dickson until
 they make enough out of it enough to pay all my just debts
 I do second and after my debts shall have been paid as above
 provided then it is my will that my estate both real and
 personal of every kind be equally divided my Son
 Benjamin to wit. James John Thomas William B. Benjamin
 B. Knight and Jane Newman and my friend Benjamin Dickson
 I do hereby direct & require that after my debts are paid
 as aforesaid that all my property real and personal be divided
 by my Executors (hereinafter appointed) and my friend
 Benjamin Dickson & James Shop into seven lots of equal
 value as near as is practicable and that each of the said
 Legatees do make for their shares and those who may share
 shares of higher value shall make the shares of lower value
 equal by paying the difference so that each may get an
 equal portion and the lots so taken by each to be possessed
 held and enjoyed by them respectively absolutely and forever
 provided however that the said Benjamin Dickson be the
 Trustee of my said daughter Thimiford Bibb and her children
 shall share in the same manner shall receive and have one
 of the said seventh portions the legal right to which I do
 hereby appoint and direct to be vested in him for the sole
 use and benefit of my said daughter Thimiford and her
 children forever the legal right and title of said portion for
 my daughter Thimiford equal to my other children to be held
 by the Trustee for the use of my said daughter during her
 life for her support maintenance and at her death to
 be divided equally between her children to her children should there
 be any of the said share remaining. I will Third and in
 as much as I wish to make the portions of each of my
 children equal in every respect and having already given
 all my children with the exception of James John Knight
 and Jane Newman a feather bed and furniture and a cow
 and calf I do hereby direct and direct when my property
 is divided as above specified that my friend Benjamin
 Dickson and James Shop first pay off and select a feather bed
 and furniture and a cow and calf for my last named
 children James John Knight and Jane Newman so that
 they shall have each a bed and furniture & a cow and calf
 more than the rest at the division the others having received

the same before this: I therefore hereby nominate & appoint
my sons James & John Knight Executors of this my last will and
Testament. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and affixed my seal this the 4th day of October A.D. 1828

In the name of God Amen: Whereas it is once appointed
for man to die & Bolny Embury of Franklin County State
of Tennessee being of sound and perfect mind and memory do
make and publish this my last will and Testament in manner
and form following, first of all I wish all my just debts
shall be settled and pecuniarily paid after which I wish
my body after death to be decently buried to its kindred rest
first I give and bequeath unto my eldest son there is fifty
dollars also I give and bequeath unto my second child a
fifty dollars after which I wish two hundred dollars to be
disposed of in the most advantageous manner in educating my
four youngest children so as to be equally divided amongst
them the name of those children are as follows, Thomas Jefferson
Minnie Elizabeth & Isabella forther it is my desire that
my lands shall be sold on a credit of one two & three years
equal installments and the whole of my other effects personal and
real estate with all my household furniture should be
sold on a credit of twelve months and the money when collected
after paying my just debts and covering the above mentioned
three hundred dollars to be disposed of as before stated
the balance together with all the moneys there due to be equally
divided amongst my eight children viz / Thomas and Minnie
Mauda Lucy Thomas Minnie Elizabeth and Isabella and I do hereby appoint
my loving Brother Thomas Embury and my trusty friend William Duncan
