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as a witness aforesaid was duly

In the name of God, Amen.
 I Levi Gant, of Sevier County, State
 of Tennessee, being this day of sound mind,
 do make and ordain this my last will and tes-
 tament.

1st I desire that my just debts and burial expen-
 es be paid, at my death out of any money I
 may have on hand, or collected from those
 owing me.

2nd I desire, after all debts have been paid, that
 all money on hand, or due me, be equally
 divided between my children, Jane Perry,
 Margaret Smithson and Levi Gant, and the
 heirs of my deceased daughter Artie Smithson
 and James Perry. (1st) I desire that the heirs
 of my deceased daughters share have the
 amount that would have been due their
 mothers. I also desire, that, should any
 of my surviving children die, that their
 heirs, if any, shall receive the amount
 that would have been due their parents.
 I desire, and direct, that where any of
 legates of my estate have had some
 debts of any character, the same be
 be accounted for, so that in all of my
 whole estate, each heir, on the expiration
 of my heirs, shall share equally in
 my whole estate.

3rd I direct, that James H. Thacker, Clerk
 of the County Court, be the
 executor of this my last will and tes-
 tament.
