I do will and bequeath unto my beloved wife Ester a negro Mank named Phillis during my said wifes life, said negro Mank Phillis and issue she may have to return to my children at my wifes decease I likewise bequeath to my said wife young man, saddle and bridle one bed Bedding and curtains and all my lands Houses and out houses during her widow hood and the profits arising thereon her bringing up clothing and maintaining and educating my children in a gentle manner and one third part of all my moveable Estate and likewise a negro boy due me by Samuel Cunningham in order to assist my said wife to support my children until she trains or my son Billy comes of age as soon as either should be the case to return immediately to my two sons —

I do will and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Ester a negro female child about six month old named Rachel which is to be appropriated and appropriated and the amount to be discounted out of her proportionable part of the personal Estate I do will and bequeath

the said ^{Wm} Phillips should have any other
children the first child said men-
tioned should have —

I do now and request my Executor to make
sale of all the residue of my personal
estate excepting two plows two set of chains
Cattle, some bridle and other things there-
unto belonging to two horses for the
use of the farm one of one mottack
and horse and then my daughters Ester
and Margaret to have each one third
part of the amount of sale of said per-
sonal Estate and of the title of my land
in that County on the matter of which
be good the two make sale of it when
they think it will be most proper and
the amount of sale of said land to be
equally divided between my wife and chil-
dren —

I do now and request to my son
James my Plantation on Big Limestone
with all houses, out houses and other
improvements to him his heirs or
assigns. (Being in Washington County) —

I do now and request unto my son
Billy the tract of land I had him
on and all my land adjoining the
same with the improvements to him
his heirs or assigns lying in Washington
and Green Counties —

I do further now and request unto my
beloved wife for the term of one
year from my decease my Negro
freeman Cuff and at the expiration
of said term if the said Negro
Cuff does behave himself honestly
and faithfully as a good servant
should —

I do hereby appoint and ordain my
trusty friends James Montgomery Junior

my Executors — and do further certify
and confirm this to be my last will
and Testament — do witness whereof I
