Thirdly and Lastly I constitute and appoint Robert Linn and John Tammert my Executors of this my last will and Testament and I do hereby utterly disavow revoke and disannul all and every other Testament or Legacy bequeaths and Executors by me in any way before named or used and bequeaths ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last will and Testament in witness whereunto I have set my Hand and Seal to these Presents the day and year first above written -
