disposed off to be paid by Alexander English & widow Twenty five dollars per year as long as she remains a widow or during her natural life or till sd same of money is expended. Also I give and bequeath unto my daughter Mary Robinson & to her children to be paid by Alexander English within two years from the probate of this my will.

Also I give and bequeath unto my daughter Mary Robinson one bed and furniture but sd bed not to be moved till next Spring.

And sd daughter Marys son Joseph Robinson one Sate clothe. one Cotton Cote. one striped jacote. one pair of Overalls.

I also give unto the children of my daughter Elizabeth Waker two Hundred dollars to be paid by Alexander English within four years probate of this year to be equally divided amongst sd heirs.

Also I give and bequeath unto Roly Hinkode Two Hundred dollars to be paid by Alexander English within six years probate of this my will.

Also I give and bequeath unto the heirs of my son Abraham English the sum of fifty dollars to be paid by the Land of Alexander English within seven years from the probate of this will to be equally divided between sd heirs.

Also I give and bequeath unto my son John English fifty dollars to be paid by Alexander English within seven years from the
