- 1- First I give and bequeath unto my loving wife Mary Newman the Plantation where on I now live with a Negro woman named Jean and a Negro boy named Benjamin with all the farming Tools Two head of Cattle Three milk cows with all the sheep. Hogs. poultry of every description with two feather beds, chests, cupboard, bureau and all the furniture both about the dwelling house. kitchen and loom house. To have to live on

and make use of as she may think proper during his natural life and then the same is to fall into the hands of my son Jacob Newman if any remains after his death and funeral.

2. Secondly - I give and bequeath unto Clair and John Nardin one negro girl named Catey that they have had in possession for a number of years with all and singular the property they have had of me -

3rd I give and bequeath unto Hannah Bowman and Joseph Bowman one Negro girl named Naley that they have had in possession at this time with all and singular every property that they have had of me or that they have in possession.

4th - I give and bequeath unto Jacob Newman one Negro boy named Calief. that is in his possession at this time with all and singular the property that he has had of me that he has in his possession at this time with this injunction on him that he shall be faithful and good ever of his mother.

5th I give and bequeath unto Rehears Newman that is now singular one boy named Hannibal, one horse or mare to be worth eighty dollars two cows, a saddle and bridle that is now called burn. two beds and their furniture one spinning wheel including all of her washing apparel that is called burn or which may be called burn or be in her possession with a chick that is now called burn -
