First I give and bequeath to Agnes my beloved wife all my lands and Tenements together with all my plantation Working Tools and household furniture for the term of her Life, and also that I have five pounds of Current money to be divided out of the Same Equally divided between my Son and Daughters by their following Names John D., Mary, James, Jane and Daniel — and the remainder I give and bequeath to my beloved Daughter Agnes—secondly I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Agnes all my Stock Both Consisting of Cattle and Horses and Hogs in like manner as before mentioned together with all my Debt and movable effects for the appointed Time of her Life
