Thirdly I give unto Christopher Conway the rent of my Plantation for three years also two hundred & seventy Bushels Corn that he has in his possession —

Fourthly I give and bequeath unto James E. Conway my Plantation lying and being in Greene County immediately below the Mouth Lick Creek not to take possession untill the year one thousand eight hundred & three when Lease will be out.

Fifthly — I give and Bequeath unto Henry Conway, four my Lots in the Town of Greeneville. No fifty one and fifty nine — also all my rights in the Greeneville
