I, Henry G. Farnsworth of the County of
 Greene and State of Tennessee being
 of sound disposing mind and memory
 do make publish and declare this to
 be my last will and Testament
 hereby revoking all other by me here-
 to fore made.

In the first place I commend my soul
 to him who gave it and my body
 to the earth from whence it came.
 Now as to the worldly estate that I have
 been blessed with in this life I
 dispose of in the following manner

RETURN.

First is my will and desire that my funeral expenses be paid out of the first money of my estate that may come into the hands of my Executor here in after named.

2nd. It is my will and desire that all my just debts be paid out of my Estate as soon as possible.

3rd It is my will and desire that my said Executor here in after named sell all of my property real and personal of every description except my Negro woman Hannah and her children which I will here in after dispose of. That said property be sold upon credit of one and two years with interest from date.

4th It is my will and desire that after the payment of all my debts and the cost and expenses incidental in the winding up my estate that the one third of the money arising from my estate be put at interest and the interest of the same be paid to my wife Mary Farnsworth during her natural life and that the interest be paid to her annually whether the principle be at interest or not and that the same be paid out of the principle.

5th It is my will and desire that the other third of my estate be paid to my brother Daniel Farnsworth to be by him and to be disposed of as he may see proper.

6th It is my will and desire that the remaining third of the money arising from my estate be put at interest and the interest arising from the

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same to be annually paid and
equally divided between my two sisters
Martha Johnson and Jane Bell during
their natural lives and upon the
death of either them the survivor to
have the entire interest of sd Third
and upon the death of both the sd
Third to be equally divided among
all of their children.

7th It is my will and desire that after
the death of my wife May Farnsworth
the said Third part of which she
is to have the interest of be
equally divided and to be paid to the
children of my sister Margaret Alexander
wife of George Alexander.

8th It is my will and desire that
my wife May Farnsworth have my Negro
Woman Sarah and her children
during her natural life and at
her death that sd woman and children
be sold by my executor and the money
arising from sd sale be put at
interest and the interest be equally
divided and paid to Martha Johnson
and Jane Bell during their natural
lives and after both of them the
said money to be equally divided
amongst all of their children.

9th I do hereby constitute and appoint
Robt A. Crawford of Greene County
Tennessee my executor with full
power and authority to fully execute
and carry into effect this my last
will and testament.
