I Isaac Baker of the County of Greene and
State of Tennessee being in a low state of
health but of perfect mind and memory thanks
be to God, calling into mind the mortality
of my body and that it is appointed for all
men once to die do make ordain and declare
this instrument to be my last will and testament
revoking all others.

First and principally I recommend my soul to
God who gave it and my body to the earth
to be buried in a decent Christian like manner
and as touching such worldly estate as God has
been pleased to bless me with in this life
I do dispose of in the following manner
first it is my will that all of my just debts
be paid out of my estate.

Then I give and bequeath to my well beloved
wife Hannah Baker during her natural life
or widowhood the use benefit and profit of
the plantation whereon I now live together
with my three negro men Charles Lige
and Jemy also my mulatto woman Dine,
one wagon and four horses all my farming
tools and horse gears with all my household
and kitchen furniture of every description
except so much of the household and kitchen
furniture as will be sufficient to set up
my two daughters Nancy and Elizabeth Baker
and my son James Baker in housekeeping

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equal to my other children already set up which I give and bequeath to the said Nancy Elizabeth and James and their heirs forever.

Then I give and bequeath to my daughter Nancy Baker my negro girl Dine and her heirs forever. Then my negro boy Eric I give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Baker together with one horse and saddle one milk cow and one heifer and that to her own proper use forever.

Then I give and bequeath to my daughter Nancy Baker one horse and saddle one milk cow and one heifer and that to her own proper use forever.

Then I give and bequeath to my son James Baker one cow and calf one sow and pigs and two sheep and that to his own proper use forever.

Then it is my will that my executors hereafter named proceed immediately after my decease to sell all the residue of my estate real and personal not herein atherwise disposed of and the monies arising from said sale divide into nine equal parts to be applied in the following manner.

First - I give and bequeath to my son John Baker one equal share after deducting from said share one hundred dollars which he has already received and that to him and his heirs forever.

Second - I give and bequeath to my son Isaac Baker one equal share after deducting six hundred dollars which he has already received and that to him and his heirs forever.

Third - I give and bequeath to my daughter Rebecca Farnsworth one equal share after deducting one hundred dollars which she has already received and my executors are hereby required to lay out the remainder of said shear in the purchase of land and the said Rebecca to have the use benefit and profit arising from said land during the term of her natural life and then to belong to her children and their heirs forever.

Fourth - I give and bequeath to my son Isaac Baker one equal shear after deducting one

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hundred dollars from said shear and that to belong to him and his heirs forever.

Fifth - I give and bequeath to my daughter Pally Allen one equal shear after deducting four hundred and fifty dollars which she has already received and that to her proper use forever.

Sixth - I give and bequeath to my son James Baker one equal shear after deducting one hundred dollars which he has already received and that to his own proper use forever.

Seventh - I give and bequeath to my daughter Nancy Baker one equal shear after deducting three hundred and fifty dollars for my negro girl Sine above named and that to belong to her and her heirs forever.

Eighth - I give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Baker one equal shear after deducting three hundred and fifty dollars for my negro boy Enoc above named and to belong to her and her heirs forever.

Ninth - I give and bequeath to my two grand children John Baker and Delila Baker son and daughter of my son William Baker deceased one equal shear and and it is my will that my executors put the same on intrust till the sd John and Delila become of said full age and then pay into their hands the principle and intrust and that to belong to them and their heirs forever. It is also my will that my mulatto woman Sine receive her freedom at the decease of my beloved wife Harmah Baker and my executors is hereby directed at the desires of my wife to make sale of of all the property that may then remain and divide the monies arising from said sale equally among all the above named heirs and that to belong to them and their heirs forever.

And whereas I have made no depositions

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of the grain on the farm where I now live it is my will that it remain on my farm for the use of the family and stock.

Lastly - I do hereby constitute and appoint William Houston and John Bragg my executors to execute this my last will and testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 31 day of December One thousand eight hundred and seventeen
