be sold & divided as follows as

thirty three cents & unto Georg Cauch
three dollars & thirty three cents &
unto Adam Cauch & John Cauch & Christ
May Elizabeth Cauch Peter Cauch - Mary
Cauch Dussanah Cauch Corbush Cauch
to be Eaqwa share in all profit
or money except the cloaths for Adams
