Secondly - I give and Bequeath to Elizabeth my Beloved wife and to her heirs and assigns forever. all my Houses Cattle, Sheep and Hogs, and also all my plot, Corn and grain of all kind, and also all my oxen, hares, plowes and all other kind of farming and Carpenter Tools of whatsoever kind and also all my beds and Bedding, furniture and all my puter and Hallow wear, and all other of my House hold stuff and Kitchen furniture of every kind and also my Daddels and Rifel Gun and all my ant standing debts and also all profit of my plantation, where on I now dwell to Enable her to discharge the Taxes that may arise on my lands, and also to Enable her to Bring up my three Daughters viz. Margant Jane and Buck to the age of Eighteen years and that she doth hereby perform the same.

I do will and order that when my Daughter Dorah shall arrive to the age of Eighteen years or in case she should not, the youngest of the Survivors do arrive to the age of eighteen years that then my Executors hereinafter mentioned are hereby empowered and ordered to dispose of my Plantation whereon I now dwell to the best advantage as they may think proper and to make ~~execute~~ and deliver Deed or Deeds of Conveyance or Conveyances to the Purchaser or purchasers of the same.

4thly - I do will and order that my Ex-
