DATE OF BILL, PROCESS, &c.

I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God and as touching such worldly estate where with it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life I give devise and dispose of the same in the following manner and from after my just debts and funeral expenses are paid out of my movable property -

- 1st I will and bequeath unto my Son Robert Henry my Plantations with all the profits and privileges thereunto belonging (the grain in the ground excepted) for the use of him and his heirs forever with all my farming utensils -
- 2^d I also bequeath unto my sons James and John Henry the sum of Twenty dollars each to be paid by my Son Robert in trade to be valued equal to cash and paid five years after my decease.
- 3^d I also will and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Schiele the sum of forty dollars and my daughter Anne Nelson, Margaret Proffren and Mary Nelson the sum of thirty dollars each for them and their heirs forever to be paid by my son Robert three years after my decease in trade equal to cash.
- 4th I will that my granddaughter Polly Nelson daughter to Joseph Nelson get my bundle Saw and one feather bed and furniture (known by the name of her Grand Mother bed) for her and her heirs forever.
- 5th I will that the remainder of my movable property be valued equal

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to each and the amount with all the
 notes and money left (after my funeral
 debts are discharged) to be divided be-
 twixt my son Robert and my daughter
 Margaret Cochran, Elizabeth Shields,
 Agnes Nelson and Mary Nelson
 each having an equal share.

6th I will that the ground now in the ground
 on my Plantation be divided equally
 between, betwixt my son Robert, my
 daughter, Elizabeth Shields and Mary
 Nelson each taking an equal part
 in gathering it.

7th I will that all the debts that may
 be due me by David and Thomas
 Watson go to making repairs on my place

8th I do hereby constitute, make and ordain
 my trusty friends Robert Henry of
 Greene County and Colonel John Blair
 of Washington County and State of
 Tennessee my sole Executors of this
 my last will and Testament.

9th I do hereby utterly disallow, revoke and
 disannul all and every other former
 testaments, wills, Legacies, Bequests and
 Executors by me in anywise before
 named, made and bequeathed ratifying
 and confirming this and no other to
 be my last will and Testament in
 witness whereof I have set my hand
 and affixed my seal this 13th day
 of June in the year of our Lord
 1866.
