Thirdly and Lastly, I appoint my beloved

sole Executor of this my last will and

Legacies or Executions by me made be-
queths or in anywise appointed here to give
allowing, acknowledging and declaring this
and no other to be my last will and
Testament and in witness whereof I
have here unto set my hand and
seal this second day of September
in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and five.
