Will and Testament that is to say I in-
 solubly and first of all I give and re-
 commend my soul to the hand of the
 Almighty God that gave it and my body
 to the earth to be buried at the discre-
 tion of my Executors and as touching
 my worldly Estate I give and dispose of
 the same in the following manner and
 form first my beloved wife Christina
 I do give to keep my plantation in
 her lands and all my moveable property
 as she remains my widow and for the
 use of the same she must keep the
 children in a Christian manner and
 if she marries she must leave the
 plantation and property only one horse
 to be with twenty five pounds and
 two cows and her bed and her chest
 and her wheel and her saddle and
 the dresser and its furniture and
 it shall be her own and the balance
 of the moveable property shall be sold
 by my Executors and the money put
 to interest then then the interest to
 go support the children and give
 them schooling if sufficient and if
 not the Executor must take of the
 balance for their support and the rent
 of the plantation is for the same use
 and further my wife shall be at full
 liberty to improve the plantation to
 the best advantage and may take
 such part of the moveable Estate
 as shall through proper by the
 Executors for that purpose so as
 not to distress the family and
 she must keep up the stock and
 moveable if not put to that use
 or lost by some unavoidable

accident and I do hereby disallow all
 other former testaments wills legacies
 bequests and Executars by me in any-
 before named wills and bequests Ratifying
 and confirming this and no other
 to be my last will and Testament
 and I do further ordain Robert
 Goin and Giles Parman, Esq. my lawfull
 Executars of this my last will & Testament
 and that they shall make a Title
 to my said plained Plot of my land
 within half a year full Charge if his
 Mother is dead or is not my widow
 at that time if he will ^{take} not the
 value of them in different persons
 and pay the other children an Equal
 share of it so that they be Equal in
 shares and if he refuses to take
 it at its value it shall be sold and
 divided in the same manner.
