In the name of God amen
 I John Dodd of the County of Greene and
 State of Tennessee being of sound mind
 and memory do make this my last
 will and testament as to what Estate
 I may be possessed of present of
 first -

1st My wife is that all my debts and
 funeral expenses be fully paid &
 how not of any debts only what my
 son Thos. has against me.

2nd My will is that my wife Dora
 Dodd formerly Dora Stone ~~except~~ shall
 have the use of my house and furniture
 as much as she need during her
 Natural life time and that she use
 any of my property she needs during
 her life time -

3^d My will is that each of lawful
 heirs shall have one dollar each
 as a gift & consider I have
 give them all their portion that
 I accrued for them except my son
 Thomas Dodd.

My will is that my son Thomas Dodd
 shall have all my land or tenements
 on property or cash that I should be
 seized or possessed of at my death except
 what will be by the above mentioned Son
 and at the death of my wife Dora
 my will is that my son Thomas Dodd
 shall possess or can all my estate
 by him being accountable for the
 above mentioned Son and likewise
 maintaining my wife Dora above
 mentioned during her Natural life
