 body to be buried in such a
 place where it shall please
 my Executors hereafter named

To appoint and now for setting my
 temporal State and such goods and
 estates and debts as it has pleased
 God for above my deserts to bestow
 upon me I order give and dispose
 of the same in manner and form
 following that is to say first I
 will that all those debts and dues
 that I owe in right or conscience
 to any manner or person or persons
 whatsoever shall be well and truly
 contented and paid within convenient
 time after my decease by my Executors
 hereafter named first of all I
 will and bequeath that my land be
 divided between my son Johnathan
 and Obediah that is to say one
 hundred acres for Josephathon to be
 taken off next to John Catesline
 including the improvement that sd
 Josephathon now have the rest to be
 Obediah only reserving the improvements
 with the mention of house and buildings
 during the natural life of my loving wife
 Susanah also I will and bequeath also
 I will the stile unto my wife Susanah
 during her life and the best of the
 fisher beds with the furniture during
 her lifetime also the Road mare
 and three head of cows four sheep
 six of the best of the Hogs and also
 a cow and piggs and also the furniture
 of all the household furniture during
 her life and at her death to be
 equally divided between Elinbeth and
 Mary my youngest child also I will
 that my son Joseph to have the five
 hundred and a half that he gave
 me of the yearlings that I have
 in Decemby one I offer two hogs
 also I will and bequeath unto my
 son Jossey two cows also my
 daughter Bice to have one and

and calf my daughter Elizabeth to have
 one feather bed with furniture two
 cows and calves one year and lam
 one sow and pigs and one cart I also
 will and bequeath to my son Johnathan
 to have the black Steer and one year
 I also my son to have the coat
 known by the name of the Flage coat
 also two horses one of them being
 now at Joseph one bedstead a filled
 box and the sow he calls his
 own, one plow and gears and a
 small plow which is at Fishers
 and one sheep also I will and be-
 queath that my daughter Mary to have
 one heifer and the red bedded steer
 one sow and pigs and one sheep and
 also the red chair and the feather
 bed that my wife have with the fur-
 niture to be given to Mary at her
 Mothers decease and I will that
 everything that is not mentioned in
 the above will shall be sold and
 divided equally amongst my wife and
 children then first paying all just
 debts out of the estate and lastly
 or hereof I have here in to set my
 hand and seal the day and year
 first above written.
