Pennsylvania being very Sick and weak
in body but of perfect mind and
memory thanks be to Almighty God
therefore calling to mind the mortality
of my Body and knowing that it is
appointed for all men once to die
do make and ordain this my last
Will and Testament that is To say
principally and first of all I give and
recommend my soul into the hands of
Almighty God that gave it me and
my Body I recommend to the Earth to be
buried in a decent Christian Burial
at the discretion of my Executors nothing
doubting but at the General Resurrection
I shall receive the same again by
the mighty power of God and as

touching such worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased God to Bless me in this life I give demise and dispose of the same in the following manner and form —

First, — I order and it is my will that all my just and lawful debts be paid —

Second — I give and bequeath unto my well beloved wife Elizabeth Thompson all and singular my lands and tenements for her support during her life together with all my Household furniture and one half of my moveable property to be settled on her for her life time; and after her decease it is my will that my Lands and Tenements together with my moveable property (Exclusive of ten pounds out of the moveable property) shall revert unto my well beloved Daughter Polly Mariott.

Third — I give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Polly — the other half of my moveable property.

Fourthly — I give and bequeath unto my Grand Daughter Elizabeth Stuart — the sum of ten pounds which is mentioned as excluded in the part of the property which is to revert to my daughter Polly Mariott on the decease of her mother which said ten pounds is to be paid unto Elizabeth Stuart when she comes of age —

Fifth, — I constitute appoint and ordain my well beloved wife Elizabeth Thompson and David Thompson Executrix and Executor of this my last will and Testament and I do hereby disallow revoke and disannul all other former wills Legacies and Bequeaths by me before named ratifying and confirming this and none other to be my last will and Testament in Witness whereof I have
