In the Name of God Amen

I Joseph White of Greene County And State of Tennessee being of Sound and perfect mind & memory blessed be God do this eleventh day of July 1805 make and publish this my Last will and Testament in manner following That is to Say -

I first give & bequeath my soul to God who have it & body to return to the dust -

I give & bequeath to my wife Jennat all the movable property & die possessed of and a Negro wench called Winney also the house and plantation I now live on after her decease the plantation to fall to my Son William also I give a small plantation lying on the north side of lick creek at lower end of my tract of land cleared by John Baker during her natural life after her decease to be sold and equally divided between my four daughters Ann Catharine Jethel & Elizabeth All the before mentioned movable property is to be disposed of as my wife Jennat thinks proper at her decease -

I bequeath to my Son William a Sorel mare I give and bequeath to my son David the Improvement he now lives on including one third of the remaining part of my lands after the above mentioned small tract cleared by John Baker and lying at the lower end of my tract is laid off David's land lying & joining Hugh Wilson's and homrags lands as far as lick creek and turning

up the meanders of said creek as as to include the bottom part of which is cleared by Bailey Baker on the south side of the creek the remaining part of my land to be equally divided between my sons Joseph and William the land I bequeath to my son Joseph to begin at the lower end of a bottom on the north side of Lick Creek known by the name of the mistle to bottom running a direct course to the open line and with the open line and divide line as as to include the one half of the land after David's land is laid off and to run in such a manner as to take the house that Joseph has built with as little injury to Williams land as possible. Likewise I do give and bequeath to my four daughters Ann Catharine, Jemel & Elizabeth ten pounds each to be paid in equal shares by my sons David Joseph & William in two years after my decease. I hereby make and ordain my sons David & Joseph Executors to this my last will and Testament.
