I give devise and dispose of the same in the following manner that is to say first it is my will and I do order that all my just debts and funeral expense be paid ^{and} satisfied first I gave to my beloved wife Mary my plantation that I now live on all my crop with full possession of all my houses and all my household furniture and all my farming tools and all carpenter tools and her choice of my two waggons and all my horse gears and spinning wheels and all thereto belonging and loom and all belonging to the same and my hogs and sheep an her choice of ten head of cattle out of my stock and her choice of four head of horse beasts out of my stock and the remainder of my stock of horses and cattle and one waggon and if my wife thinks proper to dispose of the above mentient property that I will to her she may dispose of it to sail with the remaindor of stock of horses and cattle to be sold at public sail at nine months credit and the money as

 hundred and twenty five acres of land being
 a part of the plantation that I now live on
 beginning on the south bank of Horse Creek
 on Hughes line of the sd creek the creek to
 be the line and including the big spring
 then running south line for compliment
 and one saddle and bridle - I bequeath
 and give to my two sons Lewis and John the
 remainder of my plantation that I now live
 on Equally divided by my son James when
 Lewis Comes of age ^{to the} best advantage
 he can and Lewis ^{to have the} upper part adjoining
 Ludspake likewise my son James is to run
 off Jacobs part as above mentioned I give
 and bequeath to my son Lewis my gun and
 shot bag and the lower part of my plantation
 I give and bequeath to my son John at my
 wifes decease though during her life she
 may dispose of the same in the way of
 farming with my son John when he comes
 of age And all the fore mentioned
 property that I wille to my wife at her
 death to be sold at sale at nine months
 credit and equally divided amongst all my
 Children or their heirs - And I give and
 bequeath to my daughter Larry my negro girl

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named Mary one feather bed and furniture and saddle and bridle - And I give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth my negro boy named George and one saddle and bridle one bed and furniture - And I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary my negro boy Jupiter one bed and furniture and saddle and bridle -

The above portions to be delivered at their marriages and I make and ordain my trusty friends my wife Mary and son James my soul Executrix and Executor this my last will and testament I do hereby revoke disallow and disanul all former wills legaces and bequests ratifying allowing and confirming this and this only to be my last will and testament and testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day first above written
