I give and bequeath in the following manner and form. And first I will that all my just debts be paid out of my estate.

Secondly - I give and bequeath all the remainder of my property at my decease after my debts being paid to my daughter Sarah Baly viz One roan mare four head of cattle, four head of hogs, one head and furniture. One side saddle, one little wheel, one cotton wheel, all my clothing and all my household furniture to be by him possessed and enjoyed forever -

I will that the living property be handed and sold after my decease and twelve months credit given and said Sarah to receive the money when collected. The other property not to be sold but to remain for his use. -

I likewise constitute make and ordain David Moore of the County of Greene and State of Tennessee the sole executor of this my last will and testament to take care and see the same performed according to my true intent and meaning. In witness thereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this fifth day of July in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and five

except so much of the household and kitchen
furniture as will be sufficient to set up
my two daughters Nancy and Elizabeth Baker
and my son James Baker in housekeeping
