reasonable memory coming unto mind
the Mortality of my body and knowing that
it is appointed for all men once to die
do make and ordain this my last will
and Testament that is to say principally
and first of all I give and recommend
my soul into the Hand of Almighty God
who gave it and my body I recommend
to the earth to be buried in Christian
decent burial at the discretion of
my Executors nothing doubting but at the
general resurrection I shall receive the
same again by the mighty Power
of God.

And as touching such worldly Estate where
with it hath pleased God to bless
me with in this life I give and devise
and dispose of the same in the following
Manner and form—

DATE OF BILL, PROCESS, &c.

First I give and bequeath Elected my
 dearly beloved wife The House and land
 on which I now live Let it to say my
 old and first tract of land on the
 South Side of the Camp Creek road and
 as much of my loose property House
 and kitchen furniture as she may
 want to choose. The set for House
 and the Medley Man. Two cows
 and 5 calves and also of the stock
 what she may want and of the grain
 fodder and other necessaries for food
 and raiment so much as she may
 choose this she shall have and
 hold during her widowhood or
 life time If she should choose to give
 up the said Plantation must be given
 to my son George but he must pay
 her the third of all that is made
 on said place during her widowhood
 her life time as it is my will that
 after her widowhood or after her
 decease this said Plantation shall
 belong to my son George said
 Plantation to be valued among them
 Dollars that is among my heirs
 and he shall pay the same by
 Annual payments half trade and half
 money untill all is paid not
 exceeding fifty dollars a year.
 Secondly I give and bequeath unto my
 two Sons Jonathan and Martin Lintz the
 Plantation which I bought of William
 Myers it shall be valued to them
 at Ten Hundred dollars by annual
 payments half trade and half money
 each fifty dollars annually that
 is one year after my decease
 fifty each and so on untill all

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is paid. Be it understood that sohal
 These my two sons Jonathan & Martin
 shall pay each one of them shall receive
 as it shall one hundred dollars each
 of them then the last hundred dollars to
 be equally divided between my five
 daughters which first payment to be paid
 in a year after my decease. The eldest and
 next eldest to draw next fifty dollars
 each. The next payment to the fifth
 next then to the youngest and so
 in rotation until all is paid
 fifty dollars out of my daughter
 Pelly's part must be paid to her
 daughter Lavina Gidner, my daughter
 Baily shall have her bid one cow
 and calf and one mare and the same
 all belonging to it.
 My daughter Peggy shall have one cow
 and calf a bid and sheep.
 Thirdly I give and bequeath unto my
 son Abraham the forty acres of land
 which I entered last and two hundred
 dollars which shall be paid unto
 him by my son George out of the
 land as above directed respecting
 my said tract as soon as George
 shall have the place in full pos-
 session after my decease all the lower
 property not excepted by my wife nor
 willed to my daughter Baily and Peggy
 is to be paid at Public Sale on a
 credit of twelve months and out of
 which my debts to be paid and
 the balance to belong to my wife
 the balance of the money which my
 son George is to pay on the said tract
 as above after paying Abraham his
 two hundred dollars the balance to
