I Mary Temple of the County of Greene
and State of Tennessee do declare this
my Last Will and Testament revoking
all others

First of all, my just Debts (if any) are to
punctually and speedily paid.

I Item, my Servant Phoebe having been a
good and faithful Servant to me, therefore
I do Will and order that she shall be
free and no longer a slave or servant
after my decease

I Item, To my son Thomas Temple I bequeath
my servant boy Jack, my chest, small box,
Shovel and Tong, Small and Gross Fire
chairs, and one Old cow.

I Item, To my son James Temple, I give
my cupboard, two tables, large and Gross
and two chairs

I Item To my Daughter in law Jinnery
Temple Widow of William Temple, Deed I
give my largest pot, pot rack and Hooks
one churn, one pail, my big and little
spinning wheels my raised lid Trunk, my
Cotton Cards, Tin Kettle, black & black
cow one pewter Dish three pewter plates
and two chairs.

I Item To my Daughters in law Isabella
Temple Widow of Josiah Temple Deed
I give my check reel, two Hackles and
two chairs.

Item To my Grand Daughter Mary H. Robinson daughter of Thomas Temple I give my servant Girl Lydia, small pot Six Desert. Knives and five forks.

Item To my Grand Daughter Peggy Temple, daughter of Thomas Temple, I give one feather Bed and furniture, one bedstead & my second largest pot.

Item to my Grand Daughter, Jenny Temple, daughter of Thomas Temple I give one Dutch Oven.

Item to my Grand Daughter Sally Temple daughter of Thomas Temple I give one Smoothing Iron.

Item To my Grand Son James H. Temple, Son of William Temple. Dead. I give my riding Horse.

Item To my Grand Daughter Mary H. Temple, daughter of William Temple, Dead. I give my bed, and its furniture, bedstead, my saddle and bridle, my newest Habbit, Silk Bonnet, one Dutch Oven, and one Smoothing Iron, one large bowl, half dozen Tea Cups & Saucers, half dozen Tea Spoons, one sugar bowl, & one cream Jug.

Item To my grand Daughter Maria Temple daughter of Josiah Temple Dead. I give my coffee mill.

Item To each of my deceased Son William Temple's children (Being six in number) I give the sum of four Dollars.

Item My Books to be divided as nearly equal as may be between the children of my sons Thomas, William James and Josiah.

Item To my Daughter inlaw Jinner Temple Wife of Thomas Temple, I give one large Self Dish and two painter plates.

Item To my Grand Daughter Isabella Temple, daughter of Thomas Temple, I give one white faced cow.

Item To my Grand Daughter Mary C. Temple
Daughter of John Temple decd. I give one
bed quilt, one Blanket, one bolster, five small
plates, and my Looking Glass.

Item. My body to be buried in a decent
Christian like manner and my funeral
Expence to be paid out of my Estate, and
the residue of my Estate not herein
particularly bequeathed away, and my
surplus money not appropriated, I
give and bequeath to my Son Thomas
Temple.

Item. I constitute and appoint my Son
Thomas Temple and Valentine Levier,
Executors of this my Will.

2nd day of January 1818.
