of Tennessee being sick and weak
in body but of perfect mind and
memory thanks to God the giver
of all mercies calling to mind the
mortality of my body and that it
is appointed for all men once to
die do make and testify this my
last will and Testament that is to
say principally and first of all I
recommend my soul into the hands
of Almighty God who gave it and my
body I recommend to the earth from whence
it came as to my worldly property
which it has pleased God to bless
me with I will and dispose of in
the following manner —
Viz. After my just debts and funeral
expenses are paid I will that my
wife Margaret shall live with
my son Adam Frober during her
natural life, the said Adam to
furnish her with a decent and

Plentiful maintenance during her
Natural life whereas I made a
settlement with my children on
the 20th day of August 1813. my will
is that that settlement shall stand good
those that have recd. more than one
hundred and twenty pounds shall
pay the over plus to my Ex^r with
lawful interest from the time
recd it I will that my Ex^r pay up
those that have not recd. their
part as above specify'd and make
them equal with the rest of my heirs.
the over plus (if any) to be equally
divided amongst my children. I also
will that my son Frederick shall
pay each of my Grand children, my
daughter Rebecca Smith children
(except John and Michael) the sum of
fifty dollars each as the same of age,
and good trades —

I also will and bequeath to my son
Henry Smith one dollar also I will
and bequeath to my son Henry Han
one dollar as their part of my
Estate. I will and bequeath to my
wife Margaret my cow and she
maintain'd by my son Adam —

I also will to my wife all my house
hold furniture during her life, at
her decease to be sold and divided
equally amongst my daughter Rebecca
Smith children —

I will that my Executors sell my
Smith tools, my mare, and any other
property that may be found after
my decease to the best advantage,
and be retained in their hands
and divided amongst my daughter

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Rebecca Smith children, each getting
 an equal share, or soon as they become
 of age—
 I do also appoint my sons John and
 Adam Treker to be my Ex^{rs} of this
 my last will and testament—
 Disannulling and revoking all other
 wills, legacies or bequestes here to fore
 made, ratifying and confirming this and
 no other to be my will in witness
 whereof I have here unto set my
 hand, and affix my seal this ninth
 day of Oct. 1824
