former Testament, wills, Legacies
bequests and Executors by me in
anywise before named made and
bequeathed ratifying and confirming
this and no other to be my last
will and Testament in witness
whereunto I have set my hand and
Oval this 27 day of January,
1838-

once appointed for all men to
die — I therefore do make and
ordain this my last will and
Testament in the form following
That is to say, I recommend my
body to the dust from whence
it was taken — to be buried in
decent burial at the direction of
my executors and my soul unto
God who gave it, not doubting
of their reunion at the resurrection
of the just — and as touching such
worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased
God to bless me I bequeath and
dispose of as followeth — first
I will that my funeral expenses and
all my just debts be paid out
of my estate after my decease and
I will that my wife Eva have
all my lands, house, furniture
and kitchen furniture together
