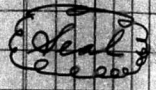

Richard Woods

In the name of God Amen I Richard  
Woods of the County of Greene and State of  
Tennessee being weak in Body but of  
Sound Memory do this third day of June  
One thousand Eight Hundred and five  
make and ordain this my last will  
and Testament in manner following, that  
is to say after paying all my just Debts, I  
give and Bequeath unto my son Washington  
Woods one hundred acres of land of the upper  
end of my tract of two Hundred and fifty  
acres, including the plantation he now  
lives on, the remainder of said tract of  
land I give and Bequeath unto my son  
Richard Mingo Woods except fifty acres  
of the lower end which I give and  
Bequeath unto my Beloved wife Sarah  
Woods during her life and at her Decease  
the said fifty acres shall be the  
property of my son Richard Mingo Woods  
Item I Give unto my Beloved Wife  
the use and labour of my Negro Boy  
named Cyrus the Bay mare and  
Coalt two Cows one Cow a Bred

Spinning Wheele the Dresser and pots a Saddle and Bridle All my farming and Iron tools I tem I give unto my son Richard Wmgor Woods a houlte known by the name of Matchless a saddle bridle and chaping as also I give unto my daughter Elizabeth Woods a Bead, Spinning Wheele Saddle and Bridle I tem I give unto my Daughter Sarah Woods a Bead Spinning wheel Saddle and Bridle I tem, I Give and Equeth Unto my three Daughters Dinnet Meetson Elizabeth and Sarah Woods an entry of two hundred Acres of land on Duck river made in the Hillsborough office to be Equally Divided amongst them my said Daughters it is my will that the Crop of Grain and Hay that is now in the Ground be for the use of of the family now living with me except fifth part of the leorn which is to belong to my Son Richard W. Woods also it is my Will that the Bees hogs young of spun yarn wolle lether in ten Shoes be for the use of the family also it is my will that my Negro Girl Hannah my horses cattle Sheep and all other property not heretofore mentioned be exposed to publick Sail and the Balance of the Monies arising from said Sail after the <sup>payment</sup> of all my just Debts to be Equally Divided amongst my three Daughters

It is also my Will that after the Death of Wife the farming and Iron tools shall be the property of my Son Richard W. Woods also it is my will that my Negro Boy Cyrus at the death of my Wife shall be Sold and the money arising from said sail together with

whatever property my said wife may  
be possessed of shall be equally divided  
amongst my three Daughters as aforesaid

and I do hereby make and ordain  
my Beloved wife Executrix and James  
Galbreath Executor of this my last Will  
Entrust for the Interests and purposes  
herein before mentioned to Execute the  
Same according to the true Intent and  
Meaning thereof
