Whereas I Samuel Brown of Green County State of Tennessee, being weak in body but Sound in memory and understanding and Calling to mind that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make and Constitute this my last will and testament in the form and manner following and as touching my worldly Estate I give and devise and dispose of in the following manner viz

First That all my just debts and funeral charges be paid, and that by selling enough of my perishable property to discharge the same.

Second That my Executor lease my land and saw mill and that the profits arising from them go to the use and Support of my beloved wife Hannah Brown and for raising and Schooling my Children, or as otherwise as may appear most proper for the support of and raising my family, until my youngest Child comes of age.

Third. I give and bequeath to my Beloved wife

Hannah Brown after my just debts and funeral be paid all my peraisable property for her use and to be at her disposal forever and after my youngest Child comes of age if my wife Hannah Brown remains to be my widow that she have her support out of the profits of my land and saw mill during her natural life times for while she remains to be my widow.

Fourthly, I give and bequeath to my two Sons Thomas H. Brown and Solomon Brown in equal proportion all my land and saw mill, by their paying my daughter Catharine Brown Seventy five dollars each in good trade, to be paid as soon as they conveniently can after they come in possession of the land when my youngest Child comes of age, or if my wife Hannah Brown remains to be my widow after my youngest Child comes of age that they come in possession of it at my wifes' death or at the end of the time that she remains to be my widow. I give it to them, their heirs and assigns for ever.

Fifthly, I constitute and appoint my father Thomas Brown and fatherinlaw Solomon Beals the Sole Executors of this my last will and testament without giving any security for the discharge of their duty therein. And I do hereby revoke, disallow, and disannul all and every other former will and Testament, Legacy, bequests and Executor by me in any wise made, willed or bequeathed, hereby ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last will and testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this fourteenth day of the sixth month one thousand eight hundred and twenty five
